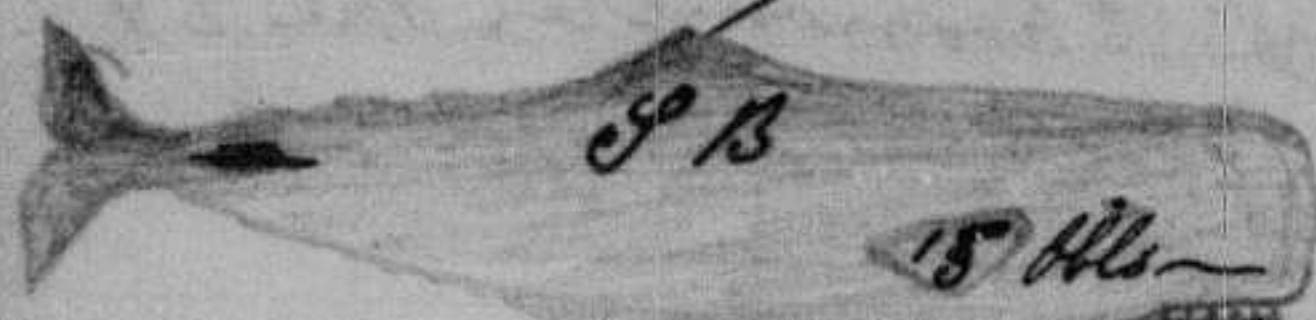


Tuesday May 30 1837
Commencement of these 24 Hours Light Breeze from the East heading to the S E at Half past 9 at 5 O'clock Saw 3 sperm Whales 3 Miles On our Lee Bow Board at Half Past Six O'clock S Boat struck at 10 O'clock took it at long side Wind S E heading East took in Sail

Middle Part Calm
Latter Part the same at all Hands Employed in cutting in at Lat by Ob 36.08
Long By Chronometer the 31st at 4 O'clock PM 74.05



Wednesday May 31 1837
Commencement of these 24 Hours Calm at 2 O'clock Made Sail Light Breeze from the South heading S E at 2 O'clock Commenced Boiling at 7 O'clock Shorten Sail heading S E

Middle Part
Wind and weather the same at 4 Wore Ship's Latte Part Calm at 11 O'clock Grampusses and Black fish going quick Made Sail Wind Wind S E and Light heading from W to E So Ends these 24 Hours Lat by Ob 36.17

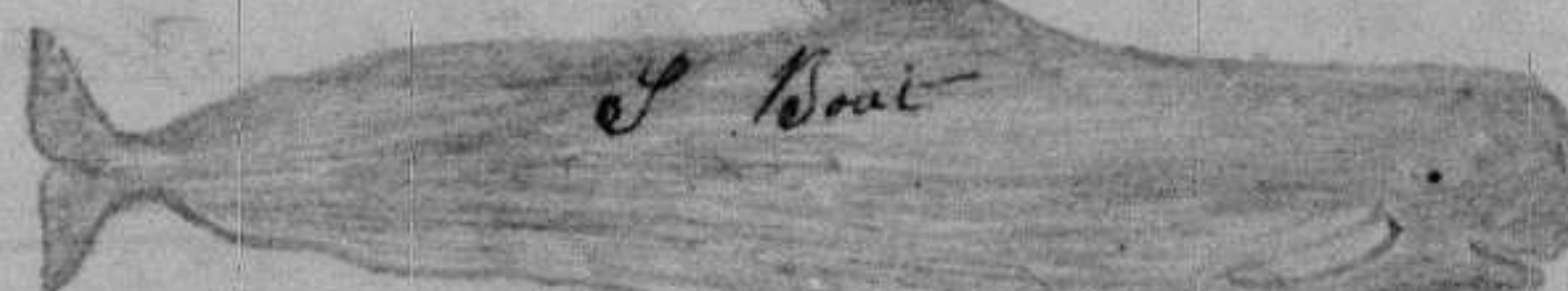


Long By Chronometer the 1st of June at 4 O'clock PM 73.35 W
Thermometer 65° Green water

Thursday June 1 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Light Breezes at 7 O'clock finish Boiling and Shorten Sail Wind S heading S E

Middle Part Calm
Latter Part the same at 6 O'clock Saw Black fish going quick Load but did not fasten at 9 O'clock Saw Black fish Load I Boat Got too I Boat got One took them along side to look for more Lat by Ob 36.30
Long By Chronometer the 2nd at 4 O'clock PM 73.23



Friday June 2 1837
Commencement of these 24 Hours Calm Saw Black fish Load Larboard Boat Got 2 Starboard Boat fasten twice But Drawd at 4 O'clock Light Breeze from South steering SW at 7 O'clock Shorten Sail Middle Part Calm

Latter Part Light Breeze from the W East steering SW at all Hands Employed in Stowing Board So Ends these 24 Hours with a Breeze of Our Larboard Bow Lat by Ob 36.09 W
Long By Chronometer the 3rd at 5 O'clock PM 74.17
