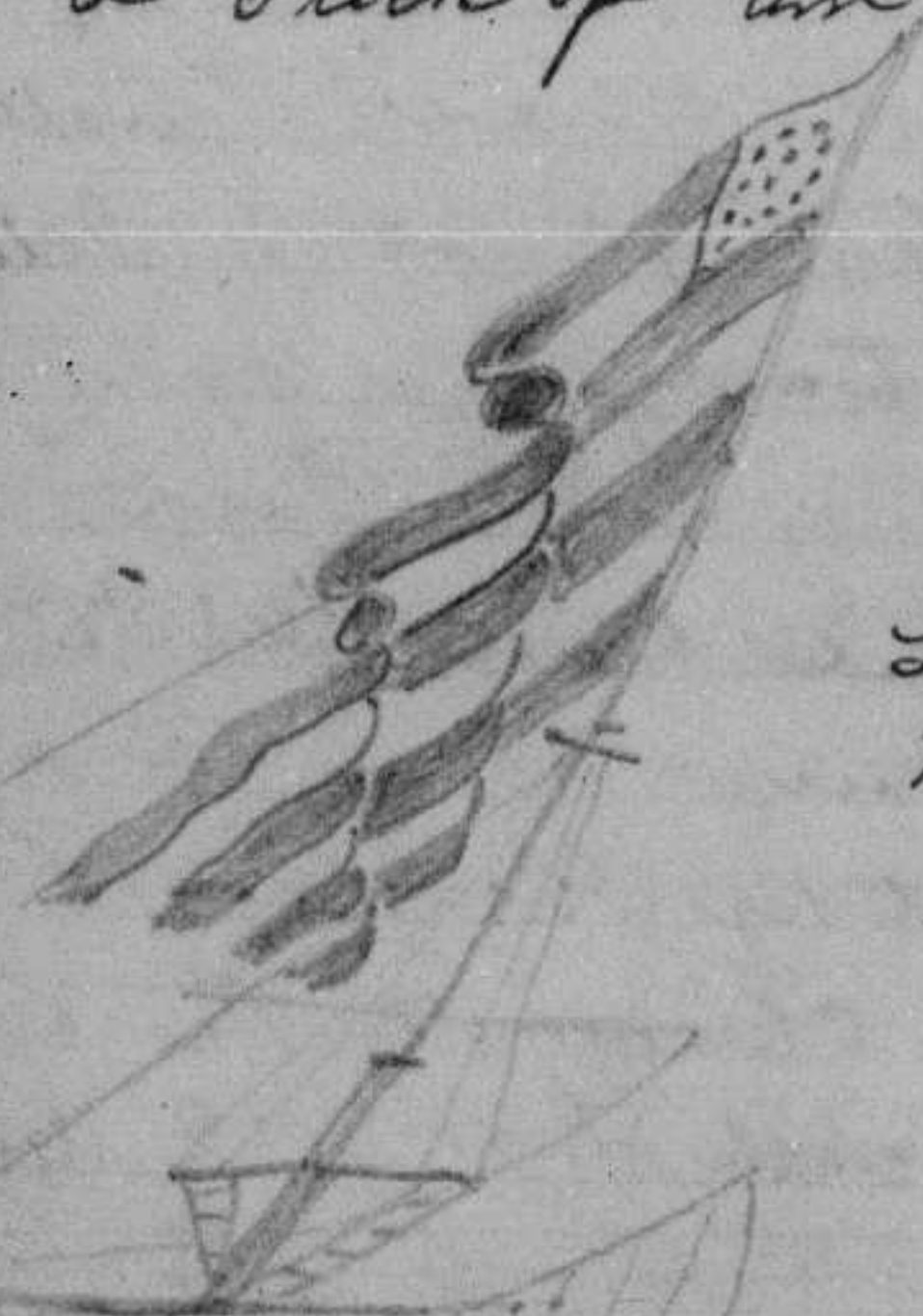


Wednesday June 7th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Pleasant Breezes from the NW heading at 2 O'clock
 hauled up at half past 6 O'clock Pick up
 a Stick of timber and spoke the Annawan
 and Shorten Sail

Middle Part Pleasant wind
 West heading to the Westward
 Latter Part Wind S-SW and
 South heading S-SW
 Breeze Breezes Saw nothing So Ends
 these 24 Hours Lat by Obs 36.52
 Long by Chronometer 78
 at 3 O'clock PM 72.10



Thursday June 8th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Pleasant Breezes and Smooth Wind SW to WSW heading
 W to NW at 7 O'clock Shorten Sail

Middle Part the Same

Latter Part fine Pleasant weather
 Wind SW heading West Saw several Sails
 So Ends these 24 Hours Lat by Obs 36.42
 Long by Chronometer 79
 at 4 O'clock PM 78.25

Friday June 9th 1837

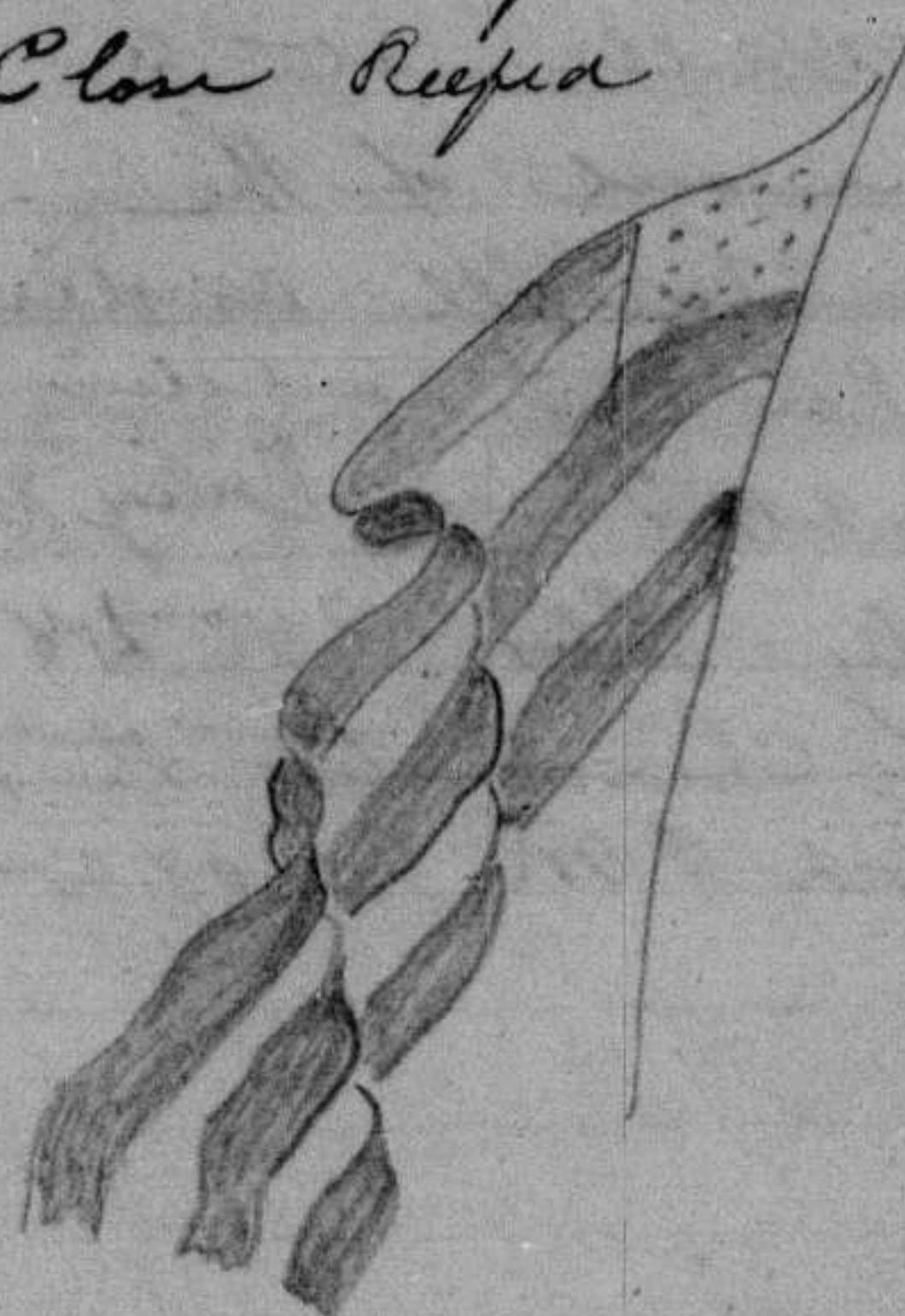
Commencement of these 24 Hours Pleasant Breezes from the NW heading to the Westward
 at 4 O'clock Saw Blackfish Load each
 Boat got One took them along side Saw
 the Annawan to Sea ward Black fishing
 at 7 O'clock Shorten Sail



Middle Part the Same
 Latter Part Pleasant Breeze
 from the W heading to the
 Westward Saw several Sails So Ends
 these 24 Hours Lat by Obs 36.18
 Long by Chronometer 78
 at 4 O'clock PM 74.22

Saturday June 10th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong Breezes
 from the W heading WSW to NW at
 3 O'clock Spoke the Brig Annawan at 5 O'clock
 Close Reeped



Middle Part the Same

Latter Part same as the middle
 at 10 O'clock wore Ship heading
 up 8 fms of 8 fms Lat by Obs
 36.59
 Long by Chronometer 78
 at 4 O'clock PM 74.47
 Saw several Sails
