Part Moderate at 12 O'clock Done Ship Wind W heading E

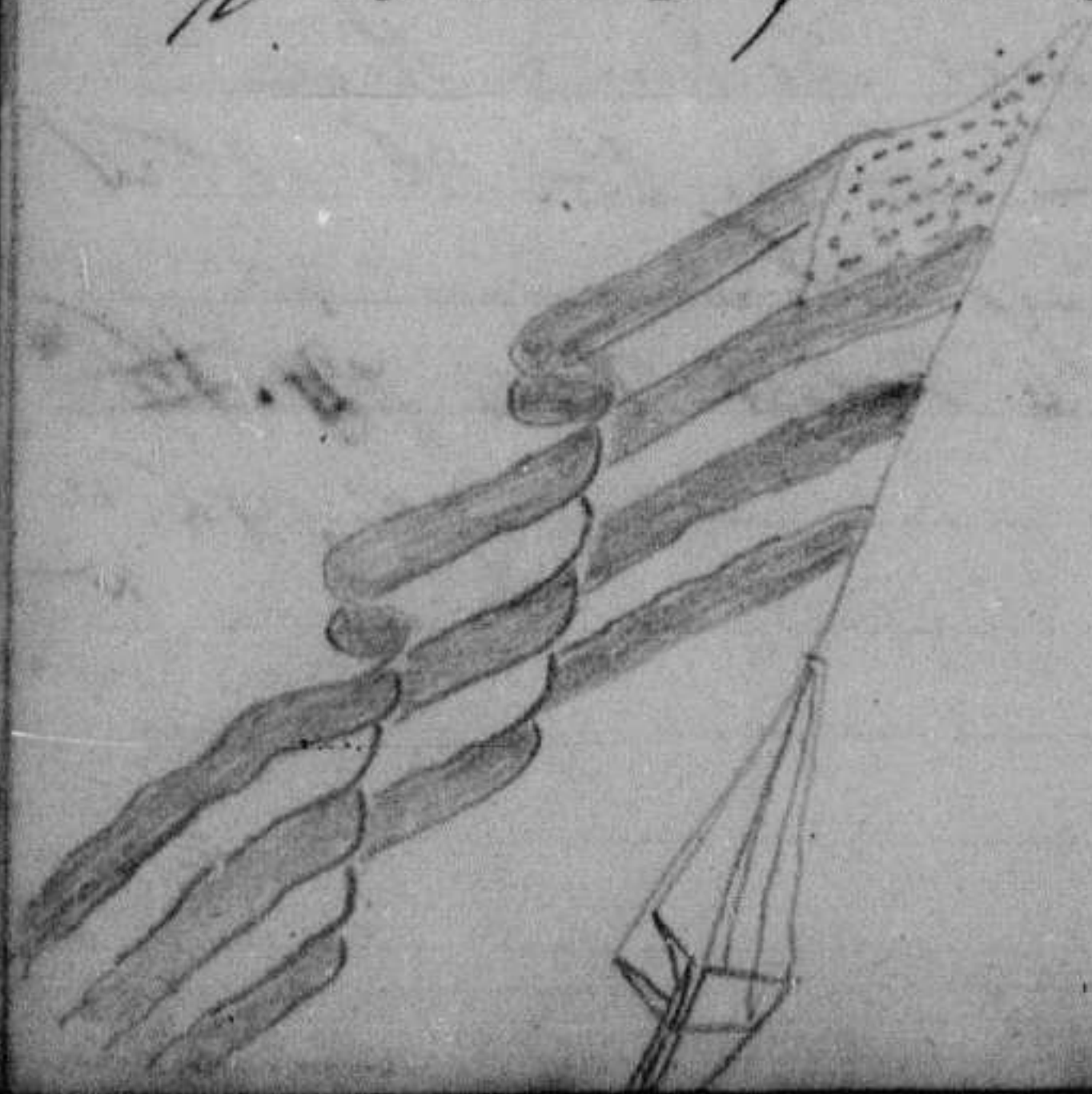
Latter Part Wind the Sun

Saw several Whales near at 9 O'clock Tack Ship to the Westward at 10 O'clock Spook the Brig

Tray of Bristol Hart 60 lbs of Oil Saw One Porpoise So Ends then 24 Hours

Long by Chronometer the 17 at 4 O'clock P.M. 73.55



Saturday June 17th 1837
Commencement of these 24 Hours Light Breeze from the W Pick up a Sheet of Wood at 7 O'clock Shorten Sail

Latter Part the Sun Calm So Ends then 24 Hours Lat by Obs 36

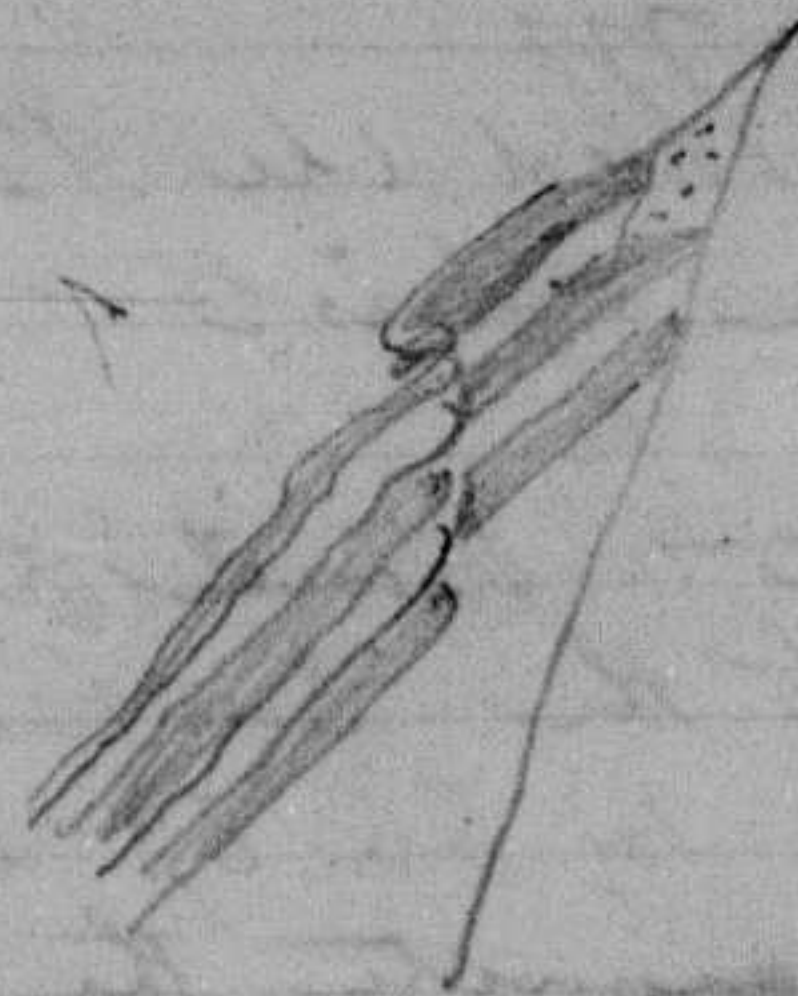
Long by Chronometer the 16 at 4 O'clock P.M. 73.56

Sunday June 18th 1837
