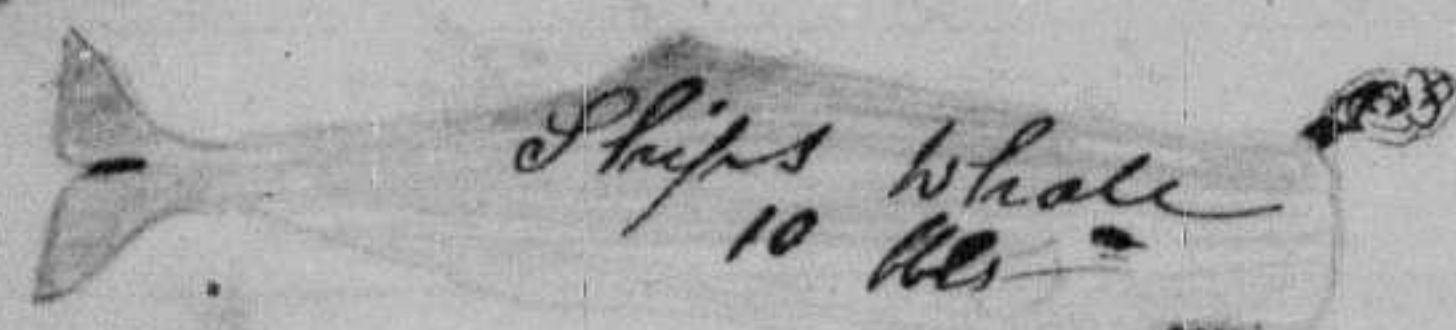


Tuesday July 25th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Thick and Squally with the Wind West Heading to NW

Middle Part the Same
Latter Part Cloudy and Breezy at 4 O'clock Tack Ship at 10 O'clock Pick up a whale took it along side and cut it in 10 ends then 24 Hours

Wednesday July 26th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Light Breeze from the North at 4 O'clock Commence Boiling

Middle Part Calm
Latter Part Light Breeze from the SE Heading West Cloudy and Rainy at 4 finish Boiling 10 ends these 24 Hours

Long by DR 35.02

Thursday July 27th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Thick and Rainy Cool down Wind SE Heading to

Middle Part Calm
Latter Part Wind to the North and Cloudy Saw several Sails 10 ends then 24 Hours

Lat by Ob 38.52
Long by DR 37.04

Friday July 28th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Moderate Breeze and Cloudy at 7 finish Slowing Down and Spoke the Riggs Crawford Capt Sells 70 Barrels of Oil 13 m out

Middle Part the Same

Latter Part Light Breeze and Smokey Saw several Sails 10 ends these 24 Hours
