from the Westward Headed to the East
So Ends these 24 Hours

Long by DR 38.59
Long by Chro 38.34

Friday August 4th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Calm
Middle Part the Same

Latter Part Light Breeze from the SSE
Headed to the East Plenty of Albatross
and Dolphin finches 1 Tareling So Ends these
24 Hours

Long by DR 38.36
Long by Chro 38.12

Saturday August 5th 1837
Commencement of these 24 Hours
Light Breeze from the WSW Headed
to the Eastward at 7 O'clock Shorten Sail
