Latter Part Same as the first
Watch Boiling black fish Saw a school of
Grampuses and a number of Gramp
and several Tails So ends these
24 hours

Tuesday August 8 1834
Commencement of these 24 hours Light
Breeze from the S E heading to the S W
Saw a school of Grampuses and several
Sails Merchant man at 7 Shorten Sail

Latter Part Brisk Breezes from the S E
Steering WSW several sails in sight Headed
to the Eastward So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday August 9 1834

Commencement of these 24 hours Brisk Breeze
from the S E Steering WSW Saw a
French Barque Steering S E at 7 O'clock
Shorten Sail

Middle Part Strong

Breezes and Clouds Latter Part Strong
Gales and blow day at 11 O'clock Heavy
Rain wind Centered from S E to SW
Took Ship to the S Eastward So ends these
24 hours
