Commencement of these 24 Hours Light Breeze from the North with a Large Swell and Saw Blackfish. Landed but could not get one. Came on Board busy mending sails at 7 Shorten Sail

Middle Part Same

Latter Part Breeze Breezes from the North at 12 O'clock Jack Ship to the Eastward So Ends these 24 Hours

Sunday August 27th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Light Breeze from the NESE Headed to the Eastward Mt Turner of Gt. Sick with the Gravel Sat Fore Topgallant Sail Sat Half Batches Banded Towards the Islands

Middle Part Breeze NESE with Passing Clouds

Latter Part Light Breeze from the NESE with a Large and Long Swell So Ends these 24 Hours

Monday August 28th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Light Breeze from the NESE Headed to the ESE

Middle Part Moderate

Latter Part the Same Wind with Passing Clouds at 9 O'clock Saw a pinback the Mate is no better So Ends these 24 Hours

Long by DR 35.39
Long by Chro 35.37

Tuesday August 29th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Light Breeze from the NW Headed to the ESE at 4 O'clock Saw a Number of Grampusses

Middle Part Breeze Breeze

Latter Part the Same Saw a Brig on our Larboard Beam the Mate the Same So Ends these 24 Hours
