a Barque Ship on our Weather Beam Head
ed the same way the Mate this Morning
is Sam better So Ends these 24 Hours

Saturday September 2nd 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Moderate
Winds from the S.E. to S.W. Headed to the West
at 8 O'clock Took Ship the Mate is not so well on
account of the fever Spitting In

Flying Seeds

Latte Part Strong breezes
and Squally and a Head Beat sea at 7
O'clock Spoke the French Brig Lat 39.5
Long 30 at 9 O'clock Took Ship to the S.W.
So Ends these 24 Hours
