

Sunday September 3rd 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong Wind
Single Reefed Saw several finbacks

Middle Part the same Wind from SE to
Headed to the SW at 12 O'clock Jack Ship to
the SE East

Latter Part More Moderate
Maid all Sail at 5 O'clock Maid Pico Bearing
E S E by Compas Dist 54 Miles by Calculation
The Mate is about the same Saw a Sail
On Our Weather Beam So Ends these 24 Hours

Monday September 4th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Lite Winds
from the SE to SE Headed to the SE Eastward
at 4 O'clock Jack Ship and spoke the Mexico
Capt Davis 6 Months Out 100 lbs Had spoke
the Annawan the day before nothing at all
at 6 O'clock Jack Ship to the SE Eastward

Middle Part Wind from S

Latter Part Wind
Lite Saw Flores Tyall and Pico and St
George the Mate is more comfortable

So Ends these 24 Hours

Tuesday September 5th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Lite
Winds from the SE to SE Headed to the Eastward

Middle Part the Wind from the South
but Perry Lite Latter Part the Wind and
Weather of the same Saw Tyall. Pico. St George
and Graciosa by all Bore SW by S Dist 39 Miles
at 12 O'clock. The Mate is more comfortable So Ends
these 24 Hours

Lat by Ob 39.3
Long by Chro 30.02

Wednesday September 6th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Lite
Winds from the South Saw several Sail

Middle Part the same Latter Part Saw
several Sail Wind from S to W the
Mate is set so well by all Bore
SE W 25 miles So Ends these 24 Hours
