

Thursday September 7th 1837
Commencement of these 24 Hours. Lite
Breeze from the Westward of the North
Head of Fyall at 4 O'clock. Tack Ship to the
North at 7 O'clock. Spoke the Brigg Lancer
Capt Munter 120 Bards

Middle Part Worth
Round the West Ends of the Islands at 12

Latter Part the same but squalling the
Mate is about the same S. Ends there all the

Friday September 8th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours
Lite Breeze from the SW at 2 O'clock
of Fyall Strong Wind Thick and Rainy
Saw a Ship in the Passage at 4 O'clock
Run out under Pico

Middle Part
Strong Gale close Reef

Latter Part
More Moderate at 12 of the West
End of Pico S. Ends there all the

Saturday September 9th 1837
Commencement of these 24 Hours Lite
Breeze from NW at 5 O'clock of Fyall
Left Mr Turner on Shore with the
Counsel

Middle Part Lite Air
from the North West on Shore to get a
man come of it

Latter Part the same
Went on Shore to get a man come
of at 12 O'clock. Several Ships Lying off
on S. E. more than 24 Hrs

Sunday 10th September 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Lite
Breeze from the SW to NW at 5 O'clock spoke the
Brigg Mexico the same as before

Middle Part fine
Breeze from the West at 12 O'clock of St
George's Head

Latter Part Strong Gale
from the Westward Run down to the East
and of Graciosa Saw several Sails at
11 O'clock Double Reefed
