

Monday September 11 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong Gale and a Large Swell on at 7 O'clock Took in all Chopper Sail

Middle Part Squalls of Rain and Thick

Later Part More

Moderate Made all Sail at 12 O'clock of the West End of Terceira Wind at 4 So on this Long Day

Tuesday September 12 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Brisk Breeze from the NW Saw 6 Whalesmen at 4 O'clock of the East End of Terceira Spoke the Brig Juana Standing to Westward

Later Part Strong Gale and Ruff Thick and Rainy at 12 O'clock Terceira Bore South West 12 miles So ends these 24 Hours

Wednesday September 13 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Lite Breeze from the NW at 2 O'clock Spoke the Troj 90 Barrels

Later Part More

Moderate Saw several Sails at 12 between Graciosa and Terceira So ends these 24 Hours

Thursday September 14 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Lite Breeze from the NW Took in the Gib to Repair Saw several Whalesmen

Middle Part Moderate

with Passing Clouds

Later Part Same as the first with Passing Clouds Saw several Whalesmen at 12 O'clock Mid way of Terceira and Graciosa So ends these 24 Hours
