Saturday, September 16th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Calm
at 4 O'clock Went to the Fore sail to Repair
Bent the Old Topsail in the Lew of it
at 7 O'clock Shorten Sail

Middle Part Brisk
Breeze from the SW Headed to the NW
eastward

Latter Part Strong Gales
Close Reefed at 5 O'clock Wore Ship to
SE Eastward at 12 O'clock the East End of
Terceira Bore SW of SE 28 Miles Wore
Ship to the NW Westward Saw a Brig Running
of SE Merchant Man by the appearance
So Ends these 24 Hours

Sunday, September 17th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong
Gales from the SW Headed to the NW Ward

Middle Part Rainy

Latter Part
More Moderate Cloudy and Rainy at 12
O'clock the West End of Terceira Bore S
Distance 30 Miles Graciosa S to 39 Miles
So Ends these 24 Hours

Monday, September 18th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong
Breezes from the SW Headed to the
NW Westward Rainy and Thick at 7 O'clock
More Moderate Fresh Ship to the South

Middle Part Calm

Latter Part
The Same and Light Squalls of Rain
Scraped the Starboard Sid. So Ends these
24 Hours 3 miles to the south of Graciosa
