 This day begins with brisk breeze
 from the NW headed to the westward
 at 4 O'clock of Graciosa Jack Ship to the
 E Eastward and Shorten Sail saw
 several sails

Middle Part Strong
 Breeze at 5 O'clock wore ship

Latter Part
 Strong Gale from the NW at 10 O'clock
 Close Reefed at 12 of the West Ends
 of Teruvia wore ship and Hove too up
 So Ends these 24 Hours

Wednesday September 20th 1837
 These 24 Hours begins with Heavy Gale
 from the West Heads NW at 4 O'clock
 the Wind heaved to NW with Heavy Showers
 of Rain

Latter Part the Same at
 9 O'clock Made all Sail with the Wind
 Lite from the West to NW wore ship
 to the Southwest at 12 O'clock Teruvia
 Bore ESE Dist 10 Miles Saw a Whaling
 Schr In Shore Employed Sail making
 So Ends these 24 Hours

Thursday September 21st 1837
 Commenced with Lite Breeze from the
 Westward with a large swell on at 2 O'clock
 Jack Ship to the North at 6 O'clock finish the
 Fore Sail and Shorten Sail

Latter Part the Same
 and Cloudy at 5 O'clock Jack Ship to
 the South at 10 O'clock Jack Ship to the
 North Saw several sails So Ends these 24 Hours

Friday September 22nd 1837
 Commencement of these 24 Hours Brisk
 Breezes from the West at 4 O'clock Jack
 Ship to the South at 6 Jack Ship to the E
 Middle Part Cloudy Latter Part the
 Same at 4 O'clock wore ship to the South
 at 10 wore ship to the E Eastward at 12
 O'clock Graciosa Bore West Dist 6 Miles
 Ends Thick and Rainy saw the Brig from
 10 Mile to Wounded So Ends these 24 Hours
