

Wednesday September 27 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong Gale from the west at 4 O'clock Spoke the Annawan etc Oil got Letters &c

Middle Part More Moderate

Latter Part the same went On Board the Lee barren to get Letters Capt Southward was On Board taking out Stones Saw the Bruce to Barrells Oil John Hunter Seaman Attended

Thursday September 28 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong Gales and Stormy from the Sw at 6 O'clock How too under St George

Middle Part Wind west

Latter Part Wind the same and Thick with a Heavy keel Ran Down under the East End of Torceria Saw to Sail in the Offing at 11 O'clock the Matapoisett How in Site from the Windward Ends with Strong Gales with Flying Seals

Friday September 29 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong Gale from the Westward at 5 O'clock Spoke the Scho 6 Months Oil 100 Barrels etc Saw the Annawan to the north at 7 More Moderate

Middle Part the same Wind from Sw to NW Latter Part Thick and Rainy and Squally at 8 Mailed Sail Wind Shift at 10 to Sw Stood out to the North Westward at 12 Spoke the Ship Tiscus of Boston Stearing Easterly So Ends these 24 Hours

Saturday September 30 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong Gale from the Westward Stood out of Turtle Head Heavy Squalls from the Westward Stood Back again

Middle Part Moderate with Light Squalls

Latter Strong Gale and heavy Ruff Saw 4 or 5 Whale men to leeward So Ends these 24 Hours
