Commencement of these 24 Hours
Strong Gale and Little Squalls of
Rain Wind from WNW to WSW
Tacking to and from under the Leaf
of Teleria in company with several
Whale men at 6 O'clock added on
More the Lee Barren

Middle Part
Much the Same
Latter Part Wind
SW to W and squally Tacking
under the Lee with the Annamawan
and Lee Barren the rest of the fleet
to Leeward So Ends these 24 Hours

Monday October 2 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours
Strong Gale from the Westward and
Thick and Rainy in comp with
the Annamawan and Lee Barren

Middle Part the Same
Latter Part Same as the first
Unbent the Main sail to Repair
bent the Fore Spencer
Saw the Annamawan and
Bruce and Sch Luisa Saw
the Brigg Mary Warbler of
Glasgow Loading at 8 & 9
So Ends these 24 Hours

Tuesday October 3 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours
Brisk Breeze from the W at 6 bent
the Main sail and went on board
the Annamawan

Middle Part Modest
and Pleasant
Latter Part the Same
Spoke Barque Arab of Fairhaven
bound to New Zealand and Brig
Emergence of Providence Town and
Brigg Bruce all Hands Employed
in filling water So Ends these 24 Hours
of Service

Wednesday October 4 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Little
Baffling Wind Employed in filling
Water to Barrels at 7 Capt Russell
and Capt Bradford came On Board
and Left Letters

Middle Part
the Same
Latter Part Same
as the middle North the wind from
NW to W and Little in company
with the Malapourit bound to
Syall came On board and Left
Letters Saw several sail to Leeward
So Ends these 24 Hours
