

Remarks on board Bark Arushonker

Monday September 16th 1861

the wind heading to the S.W. middle and latter part much like the fore part Latitude 11.48 S

Longitude 100.54 E

Tuesday September 17th 1861

this day commenced with a fresh breeze from S.E. heading S.W. by compass at 7.30 AM sail small. breacher at 8 took in main & galant sail heading the latter part about S.W. Latitude S

Longitude E

Wednesday September 18th 1861

this day commenced with a fresh breeze from about S.W. steering by the wind heading about S. and sometimes S.E. at 2.00 PM set all the light sails. latter part moderate

Latitude 16.08 S Longitude 104.10 E

Thursday September 19th 1861

this day commenced with a moderate breeze all sail set steering by the wind heading about S.W. at 2 AM the wind hauled round about S. took ship and stood to the Eastward. at 7 the wind headed as off. S.W. to take again and stood to the Southward. latter part fresh

Latitude S Longitude East

Friday September 20th 1861

this day commenced with a fresh breeze from the S.E. Bark heading to the S.W. middle and latter part strong breeze. at 5.00 PM took in main & galant sail at 8 took in the other light sails and double reefed the topsails

Saturday September 21st 1861

these twenty four hours commenced with a strong breeze from from about S.E. Bark heading about S.W. under double reefed topsails courses & jib & spanker. at 5.00 PM turned the rudd out of the top sail latter part moderate

Latitude 19.07 S

Sunday September 22nd 1861

this day commenced with a moderate breeze all sail set steering by the wind at 4.00 PM light air heading S.W. were ship and stood to the Eastward. at 10 PM moderate breeze from S.W. at 11 strong breeze latter part fresh breeze steering by compass. Latitude 21.08 S Longitude 98.59 East

From Arizier to Cape Lewis.

Monday September 23rd 1861

these twenty four hours commenced with a moderate breeze from about S.E. all sail set steering by the wind heading about S.W. by compass. at 10.00 AM calm at 3.00 PM light air the S.W. wind. Mr Hazard is troubled severely with a pellen on his finger, the cooper employed getting out a again. 2 yards latter part moderate breeze

Tuesday September 24th 1861

this day commenced with a fresh breeze all sail set steering by compass. wind from the Westward. Mr Hazard appears tonight to be in extreme pain on account of an pellen middle and latter part moderate breeze

Wednesday September 25th 1861

this day commenced with a calm at 3.00 PM slide down the logantrail haw hauled down the Stacks and jibs and hauled up the courses. at 6 slide down the top sail it being a calm and a heavy swell running from the S.W. at 12 Mid night made all sail steering S.E. light breeze from the Westward at 10 PM set all down the Main & galant yard. latter part moderate

Thursday September 26th 1861

was sent up a new main & galant yard and new top sail. this day commenced with a moderate breeze from the S.W. steering S.E. middle and latter part much like the fore part. at 4.00 PM my back commenced to ache and ached all the rest of the day in a steady pain no sensation Mr Hazard suffers very much by his finger, Latitude S

Longitude E

Friday September 27th 1861

this day commenced with a light breeze all sail set steering by the wind heading about S.W. wind from the southward. at 2.00 PM my back commenced to ache it having ached steady for twenty two hours and I have not realized a moments of sleep during that time. at 5.00 PM the middle and latter part much like the fore part at 6.00 PM took and stood to the S.W. heading S.W. wind S.E.
