Remarks on board Tuesday Dec 29th 1829
First part strong gales from from South
At 1 p.m. were ship to the westward.
Middle part moderate. At 2 p.m. were ship
to the Eastward wind S.W.
Latter part light breeze and calm.

Latitude by Obs 45:36 S Long by D 52:50
Wednesday Dec 30th

First part of these 24 hours light breezes from
S.W. & N.W. employed filling salt water to
ballast the ship. At 4 past 4 o'clock took a lunar
Obs. which give the Longitude 49:44 West
Middle part light breezes. Latter part fine
breezes in the N.W. steered S.W. & S. Ends
with thick foggy weather. Latitude by D 46:42
Long by D 52:30

Thursday Dec 31st

First part commences with light breezes with
foggy and rain. At 4 calm. Middle part, foggy
At 3 p.m. light breezes in the S.W. steered on the
western tack. Latter part brisk gales from South
to S.W. At 11 past 11 wind S.W. & W. tack ship to
the Eastward. Latitude by Obs 47:25 Long 52:00 West

Friday January 1st 1830

First of these 24 hours fresh breezes from S.W. to
S.W. steering on the Eastern tack. the weather
clear. At 2 p.m. took a lunar Obs which give the
Longitude 52:28:20 West. Middle part fresh
breezes and squally double reefed the top sails
Latter part strong breezes from S.W. the wea-
ther fair. Latitude by Obs 48:42 S Long by D 51:20

Saturday January 2^d

First part fair weather strong whole sail
breezes from S.W. and S.W. Middle part thick
cloudy weather wind from S.W. to West steering
by the wind. Latter part moderate with foggy
At 11 a.m. wind veered to the S.W. tack
ship to the westward. Ends with pleasant
weather. Latitude by Obs 50:20 South
Longitude by D 51:20 West

Cape Horn

Remarks on board Sunday January 3rd 1830

Long by lunar 51:15 W
First part moderate breezes from South and S.W.
Middle part calm. Latter part calm and pleasant
At 11 small breezes from South set the steering
sails. Latitude by Obs 50:27 South Long 51:25 W

Monday January 4th

Long by lunar 51:34
First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes
from South to S.W. Middle & Latter strong
whole sail breezes with foggy and rain. steering
S.W. Latitude by Obs 52:38 S Long by D 53:06 West

Tuesday January 5th

At 12 past meridian, hard rain. wind veer-
ed to the S.W. took in the steering sails
Middle part strong gales double reefed the
top sails. Latter part moderate with fair weather
set all sail. wind S.W. Latitude by D 53:45
Long 55:00

Wednesday January 6th

Commences with light breezes from S.W. at
4 calm. Middle part calm with thick foggy wea-
ther. Latter part light breezes from N.E. round
to S.W. the weather pleasant.

Latitude by Obs 54:44 S Long by D 55:20 W

Thursday January 7th

First part fair weather, wind veered to
West & S.W. Middle part wind S.W. with
strong breezes with rain. double reefed the top
sails. Latter part At 4 a.m. wind veered
to West and N.W. with strong gales. the
weather clear. Latitude by Obs 56:10 S Long 57:50

Friday January 8th

Commences with strong gales from N.W.
and West. At 4 quite moderate set all sail
Middle part moderate with thick weather
wind veered from West to N.E.
Latter part strong gales with rain. wind
veered from N.E. to South, a very high S.W.
awell. Latitude by D 56:38 South
