

Off Cape Horn

Remarks on board Saturday January 9th 1880
First part strong gales and squalls steering
by the wind, under double reef top sails
Middle part wind South, with strong gales
At 12 mid night were ship to the Eastward
Latter part At 4 were ship to the westward
At 8 more moderate made sail. At 11
winds veered to the S.W. Lat 50° 55' 38" Long 63° 06'

Sunday January 10th

First part of the 24 hours moderate breezes
from S.W. to W.S.W. At 2 p.m. tack to the South
Middle part wind West and W.S.W. with
thick rainy weather. Latter part strong bree-
zes in the S.W. with rain and foggy, double
reef'd the top sails. Lat 50° 05' Long 65° 52'

Monday January 11th

First & Middle part fresh breezes from
West and W.S.W. with thick foggy weather
steering by the wind to Westward. Latter
quite pleasant, wind W.S.W. At 4 part 11
were ship to S.W. Lat 50° 36' Long 66° 21'

Tuesday January 12th

First part moderate breezes from S.W. to West
steering on the Northern tack.
Middle part moderate At 2 calm.
Latter part calm. Latitude 50° 39' Long 66° 24'

Wednesday January 13th

Commences with light breezes from S.W.
At 4 fine breezes from South, saw a Sea dog
Middle part fresh breezes from S.W. with squalls
of hail. Latter part fresh breezes from S.W. and W.S.W.
under single reef top sails. At 10 a.m. saw the
Diego Ramirez bearing S.W. by compass. Distance
18 miles. At 11 were ship to the South, wind W.S.W.
Latitude by Obs 56° 58' South Longitude by the Long 68° 36' W

Thursday January 14th

First part moderate from W.S.W. Middle part
strong breezes. At 4 it veered to the W.S.W. with
rain. At 1 a.m. it veered to W.S.W. with strong breezes
double reef'd the top sails. Latter part, strong in
the S.W. Latitude by Obs 58° 05' Long 69° 20' W

Remarks on board Friday January 15th
First part moderate, wind West, and W.S.W.
set all sail. Middle fresh breezes from S.W.
and South, with rain. Latter part At 4 winds
veered to West with fresh squalls.

Latitude by Obs 58° 40' S Longitude by the Long 72° 47' W

Saturday January 16th

First part moderate breezes from West and
W.S.W. At 4 tack ship to the South.
Middle part, wind light from S.W.
Latter part, light breezes from W.S.W. and West
tack ship to the South. At 8 a.m. saw a ship to
Eastward steering to the S.W. the wind

Latitude by Obs 58° 40' S Long by the Long 72° 35' W

Sunday January 17th

First thick weather with light airs and variable
At 5 p.m. took a hard squall from the South, sheeted
sail. Middle moderate set all sail wind S.W.
Latter part pleasant, with the exception of a few
squalls of snow and hail. At 8 a.m. took a lunar
Observation which gives the longitude of 73° 31' W
Wind S.W. Latitude by Obs 57° 54' South

Monday January 18th

First part moderate breezes from S.W. with
squalls of hail. Middle part strong whole sail
breezes, wind South steering West. Latter part
fine breezes in the S.W. with cloudy weather
at the steering sails. Lat 54° 56' 45" Long 77° 35' W

Tuesday January 19th

All the 24 hours light breezes and vari-
able, at times with frequent calms.

Latitude by Obs 55° 55' S Long by the Long 79° 00' W

Wednesday January 20th

First part light breezes from the W.S.W.
headed to the South West. Middle part, thick
rainy weather. At 2 tack ship to the South
wind West. Latter part thick rainy weather
with light breezes at West inclining to the South
Latitude by Obs 56° 00' S Long by the Long 80° 25' W
