

Steering for the
Remarkson board Friday March 12th 1830

All these 24 hours get the trades with pleasant weather, steering to the westward with all drawing sail set. Lat. by Obs 1 mile South, Long. 103° 15'

Saturday March 13th

Commences light breezes with fair weather, steering to the westward. At 12 past 5 o'clock p.m. saw three sperm whales, 5 miles off to the Southward of us going to the windward, steered for them, but night came on, which obliged us to leave them, made sail and steered on our course. Latter part see porpoises and blackfish. Latitude 7 mile S. Long by Obs 105° 00' West

Sunday March 14th

Pleasant weather with light trades, see blackfish got one for lamp oil. Latter part brisk trades with fair weather, all sail set, steering N.W. Latitude by Obs 1° 34' North, Long. 107° 00' West

Monday March 15th

All these 24 hours the weather has been very unsettled, most of the time, hard rain, with light variable winds, it finally settled in the P.E. with fine breezes, course steered N.W. Latitude by D.R. 2° 50' North, Long. by Obs 108° 30'

Tuesday March 16th

All these 24 hours fine trades with fair weather steering N.W. Latter part At 8 o'clock took a lunar observation which gives the longitude 110° 22' West. Latitude At noon 4° 11' North

Wednesday March 17th

First part light breezes in the P.E. with fair weather. Middle part light breezes with hard rain. Latter part At 10 it cleared off pleasant with very light breezes. Latitude 5° 50' S. Long 111° 00'

Thursday March 18th

All these 24 hours light variable winds with squalls of rain. Latitude by Obs 3° 58' North Longitude by Account 111° 50' West

Pandewich Islands

Friday March 19th

Still light airs and variable, with rain thunder and lightning. Latitude by a glimpse of the sun (which is not often seen in this place) 6° 53' North. Longitude by Obs 112° 10' West

Saturday March 20th

First part light airs and calm, with squalls of rain. Middle part, At 2 o'clock took a fine breeze from the N.E. Latter part fair weather with fresh trades. Latitude by Obs 7° 43' North Longitude by lunar 112° 54' 30' West

Sunday March 21st

All these 24 hours strong trades with fair weather, steering N.W. Longitude by lunar At 9 o'clock 116° 17' 30' West. Latitude by Obs 9° 01' North

Monday March 22nd

All these 24 hours strong trades with fair weather, steering N.W. see man-of-war birds, boobys, tropic birds, and great many, hawks of a gray colour, settling on the water. Latitude by Obs 10° 08' S. Longitude by Obs 119° 48'

Tuesday March 23rd

Still continues strong trades with fair weather steering N.W. most of the time all sail set. Lat. by Obs 11° 30' Long. by Obs 122° 07' West

Wednesday March 24th

Strong trades with cloudy weather, steering N.W. Latitude 12° 56' Long. by Obs 125° 39'

Thursday March 25th

Still strong trades, the weather cloudy steering N.W. Lat. 13° 50' S. Long 129° 21' W

Friday March 26th

All these 24 hours strong trades in the S.E. with cloudy weather, steering N.W. Latitude by Obs 14° 37' S. Long by Obs 121° 16' West
