All these 24 hours gentle trades with
fair weather, steering N.S.W.

Latitude by Obs 20.00 S Long by Obs 165.55 W

Saturday April 24th

First part fresh trades with squally weather
steering N.W. Middle part fair weather
with gentle trades, steered West
Latter part, the same, steered N.S.W.

Latitude by Obs 20.02 S Long by Obs 168.55

Sunday April 25th

All these 24 hours gentle trades with
pleasant weather, steering N.S.W. and N.W. S
On the latter part took a lunar Obs which
gives the Longitude 171.10 W. Lat by Obs 19.43 S

Monday April 26th

Still moderate trades with pleasant
weather, steering N.W. employed mending
sails. Longitude by lunar 173.22 West
Latitude by Obs 19.30 North

Tuesday April 27th

First part moderate steering N.W. S
Middle & Latter part fine trades with
fair weather. Longitude by lunar 175.44.30
West Latitude by Obs 19.30 North

Wednesday April 28th

All these 24 hours brisk trades with
fair weather, steering West and N.S.W.
Longitude by lunar 176.32 W Lat 20.13 North

Thursday April 29th

All these 24 hours moderate breezes
from East and S.E. steering S.W. and N.W. S
Longitude by lunar 179.20 West Latitude 21.59 North

Friday April 30th

All these 24 hours light breezes and variable
steering S.W. Latitude by Obs 23.29 North
Longitude by lunar 179.45 West

Coast of Japan

Remarks on board Saturday May 1st 1830

First and Middle part light Easterly winds
with pleasant weather, steering S.S.W.

Latter part strong breezes in the S.W. with
thick rainy weather got in the fly jibboom,
see man-of-war birds, boobies, and gulls

Latitude by DR 24.50 Longitude by Obs 179.45
East, having crossed the Meridian

Sunday May 2nd

First part moderate and more pleasant
Middle & Latter part pleasant with light winds
in the S.E. steering by the wind to the
North Latitude by Obs 26.39 S Long by Obs 179.45 East

Monday May 3rd

All these 24 hours light breezes and variable
Latter part light breezes in the S.W. with
pleasant weather, see blackfish, which is the
first spouting fish I have seen (except porpoises)
since I left the Equinoctial line, and Longitude
of 110.00 West. Observed Lat 27.43 S Long 178.30 E

Tuesday May 4th

All these 24 hours light breezes and variable
from S.W. to East, with very pleasant weather
steering S.S.W. Lat. by Obs 28.14 S Long by Obs 178.10 E

Wednesday May 5th

All these 24 hours light breezes from the S.E. and
South, with very pleasant weather, steering S.S.W.
Latitude by Obs 29.26 S Long by Obs 177.40 East

Thursday May 6th

First part fine breezes from S.W. steering
S.S.W. At 6 p.m. see two fin backs. At sundown
took in sail and lay by all night, through the
night squally. Latter part rainy. At 10 cleared off
with strong breezes in the S.W. see fin backs. At
11 past a Ship steering on the southern tack.
Latitude by Obs 30.45 S Long by Obs 177.30 East

Friday May 7th

7 months of East part strong breezes double reefed the top sails
out with 100 lbs of lead. Middle part strong gales in the S.W. with a
high sea. Latter part it fell away calm
with a very high swell. Lat 30.40 North
Long by Obs 177.40 East
