

Steering for the Coast of California
 Remarks on board Wednesday November 10th 1830
 First part strong trades, lent a new mainsail
 Middle part wind increasing took in the
 jib and mainsail and close reefed the fore and
 mizen top sail. Latter part, at 8 wore ship and
 set up the rigging, then wore again, made sail
 and steered on our course. Lat 25.44 Long 157.50

Thursday November 11th

First part strong trades with squally weather
 At 1 p.m. saw a ship off the quarter steering to
 the North. Middle part wind freshening took in
 jib and mainsail. Latter part more moderate
 & set double reef top sails, steering close hauled
 heading S by E and S by E. Longitude by lunar
 157.46 West Latitude by Obs 27.72 North

Friday November 12th

First and middle part strong trades and squally
 steering by the wind heading S by E and S by E
 Latter part more moderate set all sail

Latitude by Obs 28.43 S. Long by Obs 157.20 W

Saturday November 13th

Commences with moderate trades, steering by the
 wind. At 4 p.m. calm. Middle part fine breezes
 from ESE steering S by E. Latter part light breezes with
 pleasant weather. Latitude 29.39 Long 156.20 West

Sunday November 14th

First part light airs and calm. At 2 p.m. discover
 ed the fore top mast spring stay to be parted
 in the splice of the collar, sent it down and
 replaced it anew, and put it on again.

Middle & Latter part light airs and variable
 with pleasant, steering S by E. See finbacks
 Latitude by Obs 30.08 North. Long by Obs 155.40 West

Monday November 15th

All these 24 hours light airs from the South-
 ward, with pleasant weather, steering S by E
 Employed in refitting the bottom gear
 Latitude by Obs 30.24 North

Longitude by Obs 154.50 West

Steering for California
 Remarks on board Tuesday November 16th

First part of these 24 hours light airs from the
 westward steering S by E. Middle part mod-
 erate breezes from West to S by E. Latter part wind
 moderate from ESE steering by the wind to the
 North. Ends with strong breezes from East
 Latitude by Obs 31.15 S. Longitude by Obs 154.00 West

Wednesday November 17th

Commences with strong breezes in the ESE steering
 S by E. At 2 p.m. it began to moderate. At 6 calm
 Middle part calm with fine rain. Latter part
 light airs from S by E. Latitude 31.58 Long 152.10 West

Thursday November 18th

All these 24 hours moderate breezes and variable from
 S by E to N by E, with pleasant weather, steering S by E
 See finbacks and blackfish all agoing quick to the
 westward. Latitude by Obs 33.24 Longitude by Obs 150.20 West

Friday November 19th

All these 24 hours fine breezes in the S by E with ple-
 asant weather, all sail set, steering S by E
 Latitude 34.38 Longitude by Lunar 148.50 West

Saturday November 20th

First part fine breezes from S by E steering S by E. At
 6 p.m. wind veered to the S by W with hard squall
 & took in the steering sails and double reefed
 fore and mizen top sails. Middle part more mo-
 derate with fair weather set all sail. Latter
 part fine breezes at West with fair weather
 Latitude 35.05 S. Longitude by Lunar 146.02 West

Sunday November 21th

First part fine breezes from west steering S by E
 Middle part strong gales with a very high sea
 swell, and a high sea, which obliged us to set double
 reef top sails, and steer East, before wind a sea
 Latter part at daylight it began to moderate steu-
 ring S by E. set single reef top sails. Latitude 34.53 North
 Longitude by Lunar 142.40 West

Monday November 22th

First part wind moderating set all sail
 Middle part moderate. At 4 wind veered to the N by E
 Latter part fine breezes with fair weather steering S by E
 Latitude by Obs 34.36 North
 Longitude by Lunar 139.46 West Variation 10.20 East
