Remarks on board Tuesday November 23^d 1830

All these 24 hours fine breezes in the S.W. with pleasant
weather steering E.S.E. with all sail set

Latitude by Obs 35.05 S. Longitude by lunar 136.40 West

Wednesday November 24th

First part fine breezes from N.W. with fair weather
steering E.S.E. Middle part moderate breezes from S.W.
Latter part light breezes and variable from South to N.E.
with pleasant weather. Latitude by Obs 35.16 South

Longitude by Lunar 134.40 West

Thursday November 25th

All these 24 hours light breezes in the S.E. steering
by the wind to the E.S.E. got up fore and main
to gallant yards. Latitude by Obs 35.16 Long 133.12 W.

Friday November 26th

All these 24 hours moderate breezes and varia-
ble from E.S.E. to South with fair weather steering
E by S when the wind would permit

Latitude by Obs 35.13 S Longitude by Obs 130.16 W

Saturday November 27th

First part wind moderate and variable from
S.E. to S.W. with overcast weather. Middle part
brought (S.E. to S.W. with overcast weather. Middle part
two breezes) At 10 p.m. wind veered to the S.W. with fine
breezes steering E.N.E. Latter part fine breezes
from South. Latitude 34.55 Longitude 127.45 West

Sunday November 28th

Still moderate with overcast weather. wind
variable from North to West steering East with
all sail set. Latitude by Obs 34.21 Long by Obs 124.47 W

Monday November 29th

First part moderate breezes from the westward
steering East. Middle part At 11 wind veered to
S.W. and began to breeze on. steered S.E. by E. At 4 down-
the suff. the top sails. Latter part hard gales in
the S.W. steering S.E. under close reef top sails. At 11
A.M. wind veered to S.W. in a squall. Ends strong
gales and squally. Lat by Obs 33.00 Long by Obs West

Tuesday November 30th All these 24 hours strong gales
from S.W. with a high sea steering S.E. by E. Middle
part set whole top sails and main top gallant
miles. Latitude by Obs 32.40 Longitude by a star on
the side of the At 11 P.M. was 123.00 West

Coast of California

Remarks on board Wednesday December 1st 1830

First part strong breezes from N.W. with hard
squalls steering S.E. by E. Middle part strong breezes
took in the steering sails and steered S.E. (wind
S.W.) for the Island of Guadalupe. Latter part At
5 P.M. saw the Island. South part bearing S.E. distant
20 miles. set all the steering sails and steered S.E. by E.
and passed to the Eastward of the Island. The land
is moderately elevated and appears to be destitute of
wood, except on the East part, where there is a
few scattering trees. I made the South part of the Island
to be in the Latitude of 28.54 S by a meridian Altitude
of the Sun. South part bearing N.W. at noon

Thursday December 2^d

First part fresh breezes from S.W. and squally steering
N.E. Middle part moderate with fair weather Latter
part fine weather with moderate breezes from South
steering S.E. by E. employed squaring and painting the
boats and bending old sails

Latitude by Obs 27.12 S Longitude by Obs 145.42 W

Friday December 3^d

First part of these 24 hours moderate breezes from S.W.
with overcast weather steering S.E. by E. Middle part
fine breezes in the S.W. steering S.E. by E. with pleasant
weather. At 4 P.M. took a lunar Obs. by a star each side
of the moon which give the Longitude 115.50 W
Latter part fine breezes employed mending sails
Latitude by Obs 25.17 S Long At noon West

Saturday December 4th

All these 24 hours fine breezes from S.W. and S.W.
steering S.E. by E. and S.E. On the latter part At daylight
saw the main land. 10 Leagues Distance. got out the
fly jibboom. Latitude by Obs 23.47 South

Sunday December 5th

First part moderate breezes from South steering S.E. by E.
Middle part At 9 wind veered to the S.W. with
fresh breezes At 3 P.M. it veered the S.W. with light
breezes Latter part light airs from the South with overcast
weather. Latitude by Obs 22.27 S. Cape St Lucas bearing South

Monday December 6th

First part light airs and variable with calms land
20 miles off. Middle part light breezes from South to
west steering S.E. by E. Latter part moderate breezes from
S.W. to S.W. with pleasant weather. Employed
mending and bending old sails.
Latitude by Obs 21.47 Longitude 109.15 West
