

Passage to Cape Horn
Remarks on board Tuesday June 4th 1832
First & Middle part wind South & S.E. with fair weather steering by the wind to the Eastward
Latter part strong breezes from South double reefed the top sails

Wednesday June 5th

First part strong breezes with fair weather. Middle part took in jib & main sail. Latter part wind S.E. & S.W. wave ship and steered to the S.W.

Latitude by Obs 25.19 S Long by Lunar 146.20 W

Thursday June 6th

All the 24 hours fresh breezes from S.E. & S.W. and very fluky steering by the wind to the S.W.

Latitude by Obs 25.58 S Long by Ac 147.10 W

Friday June 7th

First part more moderate wind S.E. & S.W. single reef and top gallant sails Middle part very squally Latter part fresh breezes with fair weather wind S.E. & S.W. Latitude by Obs 27.17 S Long 147.30 W

Saturday June 8th

First & Middle part fresh breezes from S.E. steering South Latter part moderate and pleasant, sent down the fore top sail and put a half of new canvas in to it. Lat 28.55 S Long 147.30 W

Sunday June 9th

First part pleasant wind East and S.E. finished the fore top sail and sent it Middle part wind veered to S.W. with fine breeze at the steering sails. Latter part moderate breezes with pleasant weather steering S.E. & S.W. Employed repairing an old fore top sail. Lat 29.56 S Long 146.00 W

Monday June 10th

First part S.W. wind veered to S.W. and South with rain Middle part S.W. & S.W. wind veered to S.E. fine breezes with thick weather Latter part wind North with breezes with rain. Lat 30.47 S Long 144.30 W

Tuesday June 11th

First part wind S.W. & S.W. fine breezes with rain steering S.E. & S.W. Middle part strong gales with rain double reefed the top sails. Latter part wind S.W. to East strong gales with squalls Latitude by Obs 32.18 S Long by Ac 143.32 W

Passage to Cape Horn
Remarks on board Wednesday June 13th
First part wind began to moderate. Middle part quite moderate at all sail wind S.E. Latter part light air and variable from S.E. to S.W. At 11 AM took 3 ship to the Eastward Latitude by Obs 33.24 S Long by Ac 148.30 W

Thursday June 14th

First part light air and calm with overcast weather Middle part at 9 PM took a fine breeze from S.W. steered S.E. Latter part fresh breezes from South. Lat 33.39 S Long 148.30 W

Friday June 15th

First part fresh whole sail breezes from South & S.E. with fair weather steering close hauled to the Eastward Middle part wind light and variable. At 6 PM Latter part took 3 ship to the South. wind light and variable from S.E. to East. Latitude by Obs 33.27 S Long by Ac 149.30 W

Saturday June 16th

First part wind moderate and variable from East to S.E. with overcast weather. wind very fluky at times there is as much as we can carry all sail too, then be nearly a calm for some time, which has been the case for several days past Middle part wind S.E. Latter part fresh breezes from S.E. and S.W. steering S.E. Latitude by Obs 34.37 S Long by Ac 140.15 W

Sunday June 17th

First part fresh breezes from S.E. steering S.E. At 7 PM single reefed the top sails Middle part double reefed fore and main Latter part strong gales from North took in the main and Starboard. Quarter boats Latitude by Obs 36.04 S Long by Ac 137.30 W

Monday June 18th

First part strong breezes from North & S.W. with rain steering S.E. under double reefed top sails Middle part still raining with fresh breezes. Latter part moderate, set all sail. Lat by Obs 37.11 S Long 135.20 W

Tuesday June 19th

First part moderate breezes from S.W. with foggy & rain. Middle & Latter part fine breezes with clear weather steering S.E. & S.W. Lat 38.11 S Long by Ac 132.30 S Long by Ac 134.20 W

Wednesday June 20th

All the 24 hours fine breezes from North with fair weather steering S.E. & S.W. Latitude by Obs 39.28 S Long by Ac 131.00 W

Thursday June 21th

All the 24 hours fresh breezes from North with fair weather carrying all sail, steering S.E. Latitude by Obs 40.18 S Long by Ac 127.40 W
