

Remarks on Tuesday November 4th 1845

Commenced with a gale from the S.E. and squally rugged weather heading sharp by the E.S. under close reefed topsails. Middle part strong breeze and heavy squalls latter part ditto at 4 o'clock ship to the N.W. and made sail at 5 o'clock. Latitude 33° 30' N. Longitude 63° 30' W.

Remarks on Wednesday Nov 5th

Commenced with a strong gale from the N.E. and squally rainy weather heading to the S.W. under short sail. Middle part ditto latter part at 3 a.m. the wind shifted to the N.W. and made sail at 7 a.m. all sail set at 8 a.m. a sail steering to the N.E. Latitude 35° 58' N. Longitude 66° 09' W.

Remarks on Thursday Nov 6th

Commenced with a moderate breeze from the West and overcast weather steering to the N.E. with all sail set one brig in sight. Middle part light squalls latter part ditto heading S.E. Employed in jitting for whaling. Latitude 35° 02' N. Longitude 62° 31' W.

Remarks on Friday Nov 7th

Commenced with strong breeze from the N.W. and overcast weather steering to the S.E. with all sail set at 4 p.m. spoke a brig from Halifax bound to Birmingham. Middle part squally latter part ditto. Latitude 34° 09' N. Longitude 63° 15' W.

Remarks on Saturday Nov 8th

Came with strong winds from the S.W. to West and overcast weather steering to E.S. with all sail set one sail to leeward. Middle part strong breeze and pleasant latter part ditto at 11 squally. Latitude 33° 58' N. Longitude 68° 10' W.

Remarks on Sunday November 9th 1845

Commenced with strong wind from the S.W. and squally steering to the E.S. with all sail set at 3 p.m. took heavy squalls attended with rain at night calm. Middle part light breeze latter part ditto. Latitude 33° 23' N. Longitude 68° 08' W.

Remarks on Monday November 10th

Came with light air & calm steering to the East at night the rain increased. Middle part strong breeze latter part ditto saw finbacks & employed in jitting ship for whaling. Latitude 33° 45' N. Longitude 63° 04' W.

Remarks on Tuesday Nov 11th

Came with strong breeze from the South and overcast steering to the E.S. with all sail set saw finbacks & Middle part fine weather latter part ditto. Latitude 33° 55' N. Longitude 64° 55' W.

Remarks on Wednesday Nov 12th

Came with strong winds from the South and overcast weather steering to the E.S. with all sail set at 4 p.m. took the wind from the N.W. attended with heavy rain at 8 more pleasant wind from the N.W. Middle part fine weather latter part at day light the wind halled to the Eastward heading to the E.S. Latitude 33° 40' N. Longitude 45° 03' W.

Remarks on Thursday Nov 13th

Came with light breeze from the E.S. and pleasant weather heading sharp by the N.E. with all sail set. Middle part light breeze latter part wind all around at 10 heading to the E.S. Latitude 33° 35' N. Longitude 44° 45' W.
