

Remarks on Thursday December 4th 1845

Commenced with strong winds from the South and overcast weather at 1 p.m. made to the N.W. at 3 p.m. back Middle part light air & Calms latter part heading to the S.W. at 5 p.m. back to the N.W. at 6 p.m. heading to the S.W. Lat 4. 05.50 N Long 23. 47 W

Remarks on Friday Dec 5th

Came with strong breezes from the South and squally weather heading sharp by the S.W. with all sail set Middle part light air latter part squally & sail in site at 10 a.m. pass a large Dutch Merchant ship Lat 4. 05.50 N Long 23. 47 W

Remarks on Saturday Dec 6th

Came with light breezes from the S.E. and fine pleasant weather heading sharp by the S.W. at 2 p.m. saw a large English bark with Great number of Ladies & Gent on board exchange Long streets differed 5 miles he was to the west of us Middle part strong trades latter part more moderate heading to the S.W. Lat 4. 05.50 N Long 23. 47 W

Remarks on Sunday Dec 7th

Came with strong breezes and pleasant heading to the S.W. at 10 a.m. Middle part moderate latter part ditto Lat 4. 05.50 N Long 23. 47 W

Remarks on Monday Dec 8th

Came with light trades from the S.E. to S.W. and fine pleasant weather heading to the S.W. at 2 p.m. spoke the Bark ship, Adam of London 33 days out bound to Hobart & town the Doctor came on board to see a sick man and prescribe Medicine for him Middle part heading to the S.W. latter part heading sharp by the S.W. Middle part ship in site Lat 4. 05.50 N Long 23. 47 W

Remarks on Tuesday December 9th 1845

Came with moderate trades from the S.E. and fine pleasant weather heading sharp by the S.W. with all sail set Middle part strong trades latter part moderate one sail in site Lat 4. 05.50 N Long 23. 47 W

Remarks on Wednesday Dec 10th

Came with light trades from the S.E. and fine pleasant weather heading to the S.W. at 2 p.m. have back for the Bark Adam to come up at 2 p.m. lowered the boat and went on board for the doctor to see the above sick man at 3 p.m. the boat come with 4 English Ministers and one was the Arch Deacon of Wandsworth Lane at 4 p.m. boat went on board with the passengers & Middle part light breeze latter part ditto one person still in site and our sick man is convalescent Lat 4. 05.50 N Long 23. 47 W

Remarks on Thursday Dec 11th

Came with light trades from the S.E. and fine pleasant weather heading to the S.W. with all sail set at 2 p.m. saw a hermétique brig strong to the N.W. at 8 p.m. at the shoaling of Middle part steering ditto latter part at 8 a.m. the wind backed to the N.E. at 10 a.m. saw a large Lat 4. 05.50 N Long 23. 47 W

Remarks on Friday Dec 12th

Came with fine breezes from the N.E. to E.N.E. and fine pleasant weather steering to the S.W. with all sail set Middle part strong breeze latter part ditto Lat 4. 05.50 N Long 23. 47 W

Remarks on Saturday Dec 13th

Came with strong breezes from the N.E. and fine weather steering to the S.W. with all sail in Middle part strong winds latter part ditto Empress Coopering provisions Lat 4. 05.50 N Long 23. 47 W
