

Remarks on Thursday March 13th 1845.

Commenced with light air from the E to SE and hot weather heading to the NW. Middle part light air & calms. Latter part ditto steering to the NW saw porpoises. Lat by Obs 7. 14. N. Long by Chr 103. 50 W.

Remarks on Friday March 13th

Commenced with light breeze from the NE and pleasant weather steering to the NW with all sail set. Middle part light breeze and almost calm. Latter part ditto. Lat by Obs 8. 16. N. Long by Chr 106. 42 W.

Remarks on Saturday March 14th

Commenced with light breeze from the NE and squally weather heading sharp by the NW saw porpoises & Middle part much rain & lightning. Latter squally with rain. Lat by Obs 9. 05. N. Long by Chr 107. 50 W.

Remarks on Sunday 16th 15th

Commenced with strong breeze from the NE and squally rainy weather at night. more pleasant. Middle part the wind from the NE. Latter ditto steering to the NW. Lat by Obs 10. 06. N. Long by Chr 111. 08 W.

Remarks on Monday 15th

Commenced with strong winds from the NE and pleasant steering to the NW with all sail set. Middle part squally. Latter part more pleasant. Lat by Obs 11. 06. N. Long by Chr 113. 24 W.

Remarks on Tuesday March 17th

Commenced with moderate trades from the NE to East and squally steering to the NW with all sail set. Middle part squally with rain. Thunder & lightning. Latter heavy rain and strong trades and squally weather. Lat by Obs 12. 05. N. Long by Chr 116. 50 W.

Remarks on Wednesday March 15th 1845

Commenced with strong trades from the NE to East and squally rainy weather. Middle part squally. Latter more pleasant steering to the NW. Lat by Obs 13. 21. N. Long by Chr 120. 20 W.

Remarks on Thursday March 19th

Commenced with strong trades from the NE to ENE and squally weather steering to the NW with all possible sail set. Middle part squally. Latter part strong trades saw porpoises. Lat by Obs 12. 56. N. Long by Chr 124. 00 W.

Remarks on Friday March 20th

Commenced with strong trades from the NE and squally weather steering to the NW. Middle part ditto. Latter part heavy squally with strong trades and overcast. Lat by Obs 13. 42. N. Long by Chr 127. 30 W.

Remarks on Saturday March 21st

Commenced with strong trades from the NE & squally rugged weather steering to the NW. Middle part heavy trades. Latter ditto all sail on that she will bare. Lat by Obs 14. 36. N. Long by Chr 131. 19 W.

Remarks on Sunday March 22nd

Commenced with strong trades from the NE to ENE and squally weather steering to the NW. Middle part light trades. Latter part ditto saw some plank Rats &c. Lat by Obs 15. 12. N. Long by Chr 134. 33 W.

Remarks on Monday March 23rd

Commenced with light trades from the NE to East and overcast steering to the NW with all sail set. Middle part light air & calms with rain. Latter part ditto much fogging. Lat by Obs 15. 42. N. Long by Chr 136. 50 W.
