Commenced with light
airs from the E. & E. and overcast steering to the W. by N.
Middle part calm & rainy latter at 6 a.m. took a
light breeze from the W. by N. heading sharp by the
W. by N. with light squalls

Remarks on Wednesday March 25th

Commenced with light
breezes from the N. & E. and squally rainy weather heading
to the W. by N. Middle part squally with rain latter
part. fair & more pleasant

Long. by Obs. 146° 39' W

Remarks on Thursday March 26th

Commenced with light
airs from the S. & W. and pleasant heading sharp by the
W. by N. with all sail set. Middle part light airs & calm
latter part ditto with a dull time

Lat. by Obs. 16° 22' N
Long. by Obs. 142° 15' W

Remarks on Friday March 27th

Commenced with light
airs & calms steering to the W. by N. Middle part
winds from the North to E. & E. latter part winds ditto
steering to the W. by N.

Lat. by Obs. 16° 59' N
Long. by Obs. 146° 55' W

Remarks on Saturday March 28th

Commenced with light breezes
from the N. & E. to East and pleasant weather steering
to the W. by N. with all sail on but slow headway
Middle part light breezes & pleasant latter part
the wind hauled to the E. & E. & E.

Long. by Obs. 146° 09' W

Remarks on Sunday March 29th

Came with light airs from
the East and overcast steering to the W. & W. Middle
part light airs & calms latter the wind from the E. & E. & E.
with light rain

Lat. by Obs. 18° 31' N
Long. by Acc. 148° 10' W

Remarks on Monday March 30th 1840

Commenced with light airs
from the E. & E. and rainy weather steering to the
W. by N. saw nothing. Middle part strong breeze latter
part the wind hauled to the South attended with rain
and heavy squalls at 10 the W.

Long. by Acc. 151° 00' W

Remarks on Tuesday March 31st

Came with strong winds from
the S. & W. to west and squally rainy weather heading sharp by the
W. by N. under double reef. Middle part squally latter part
more moderate at 10 all sail on

Lat. by Acc. 21° 10' N
Long. by Obs. 152° 15' W

Remarks on Wednesday April 1st

Commenced with strong winds
from the west and squally rugged weather heading to the
W. by N. to W. by N. at 4 p.m. tack to the S. & W. Middle part
strong winds and rugged latter part more pleasant heading
sharp by the W. by N. at 10 almost calm

Long. by Obs. 152° 08' W

Long. by O. & C. 152° 25' W

Remarks on Thursday April 2nd

Commenced with light airs
& calms heading to the west with a heavy sea on Middle
part calm latter part ditto at 6 a.m. saw two sails heading
to the westward

Long. by O. & C. 152° 35' W

Remarks on Friday April 3rd

Came with light airs from the
E. & E. and fine pleasant weather heading to the W. by N.
Middle part light air & calms latter part light breezes at
6 a.m. saw 1 sail heading to the west
