

Remarks on Monday July 27th 1845

Come with strong winds from the west and pleasant weather steering to the S.W. with all sail set at 5 am saw an excess of birds & at night took in sail heading S.E. at 11 pm saw a ship a bark and a schooner at daylight latter at 7 am spoke the ship Isabella of New Bedford 1500 tons on Sag Harbor ship a bark at 10 started to the N.E. Lat 49.30 N. Long 149.10 W.

Remarks on Tuesday July 28th

Come with strong winds from the west and squally rugged weather heading to the S.E. under double reef at night and moderate middle part almost calm latter thick fog heading to the N.E. under ~~all~~ sail at 10 am pleasant. Lat 50.10 N. Long 149.30 W.

Remarks on Wednesday July 29th

Come with light breeze from the N.W. and foggy weather heading sharp by the N.E. saw nothing at night double reef. Middle part heading to the N.E. latter part heading S.W. Lat 49.05 N. Long 149.05 W.

Remarks on Thursday July 30th

Come with the light breeze from the N.W. and foggy weather heading to the N.E. at 1 pm saw 2 ships at 5 pm spoke the ship Mabel & whale. At 6 pm spoke the ship Cadmus & whale Middle part calm latter part took a light breeze from the South steering sharp by the S.E. saw & lost the Thomas Dickerson Lat 49.53 N. Long 146.21 W.

Remarks on Friday July 31st

Come with strong winds from the South to S.W. and thick foggy weather heading sharp by the S.E. the above ship out of site a strong middle part strong wind and fog latter part date heading from S.E. to S.W. saw some whale birds & Lat 48.10 N. Long 145.50 W.

Remarks on Saturday August 1st 1845

Commenced with strong winds from the N.W. and squally rugged weather heading sharp by the S.E. under double reefs saw birds & Middle part heading to the S.E. latter part heading date with fog Lat 45.06 N. Long 142.49 W.

Remarks on Sunday August 2nd

Come with strong winds from the west and foggy weather heading to the S.E. at 2 left to the middle heading to the N.W. Middle part heading to the S.W. latter part date so ends with fog & Lat 45.42 N. Long 144.11 W.

Remarks on Monday August 3rd

Come with light breeze from the N.W. and thick overcast weather heading sharp by the N.W. saw cow fish & Middle part light air & calm latter part all saw. Saw porpoises cow fish and porpoise Lat 45.02 N. Long 144.33 W.

Remarks on Tuesday August 4th

Come with light air from the N.W. and pleasant weather heading to the S.E. saw porpoise & Middle part moderate latter part strong breeze and squally with rain saw finbacks & Lat 45.17 N. Long 144.45 W.

Remarks on Wednesday August 5th

Come with strong winds from the west and overcast steering to the S.W. with all sail set at night set the royals & Middle part moderate latter part squally with rain employed in scrubbing bone setting up fresh water Shooks & Lat 45.30 N. Long 145.10 W.

Remarks on Thursday August 6th

Come with light winds from the North and over cast weather steering to the S.W. at night steered South Middle part date latter part light breeze and light squalls Lat 45.30 N. Long 145.45 W.
