

Remarks on Friday August 7<sup>th</sup> 1842

Commenced with light breeze from the North and light squalls steering to the South with all sail set temp in drying Bone & Middle part moderate latter part ditto Lat of Obs 34.24 N Long of Obs 145.51 W

Remarks on Saturday August 8<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with light breeze from the North and pleasant steering to the North at 5h AM steered S.W. Made part light and calm latter took squalls of rain & wind variable Lat of Obs 32.56 N Long of Obs 146.30 W

Remarks on Sunday August 9<sup>th</sup>

Came with light breeze from the North and squally weather steering to the S.W. Middle part light and calm latter part ditto Lat of Obs 31.09 N Long of Obs 147.50 W

Remarks on Monday August 10<sup>th</sup>

Came with light breeze and calm steering to the S.W. with all sail set. Middle part squally winds from the N.E. to East latter part ditto steering S.W. with all the rigging out. Lat of Obs 29.09 N Long of Obs 149.00 W

Remarks on Tuesday August 11<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with strong Trades from the East to N.E. and squally steering to the S.W. with all sail set going about 10 hours to Middle part squally latter part ditto with rain Lat of Obs 26.55 N Long of Obs 150.46 W

Remarks on Wednesday August 12<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with moderate Trades from the N.E. to East and squally rainy weather steering to the S.W. with all sail set. Middle part squally latter part pleasant steering to the S.W. Lat of Obs 24.22 N Long of Obs 152.22 W

Remarks on Thursday August 13<sup>th</sup> 1842

Commenced with strong Trades from the N.E. to East and pleasant weather steering to the S.W. with all sail set. Middle part strong Trades and squally latter part pleasant steering to the S.W. Lat of Obs 21.31 N Long of Obs 153.25 W

Remarks on Friday August 14<sup>th</sup> 1842

Commenced with strong Trades from the N.E. to East and squally weather steering to the S.W. at 11 PM steered to the N.E. Middle part strong Trades & squally latter part ditto steering to the N.E. at 10 AM saw Curly hee bearing N.W. Dist of East 65 miles Lat of Obs 21.05 N Long of Obs 155.00 W

Remarks on Saturday August 15<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with strong Trades from the East to E.S. and squally rainy weather steering to the West. at 11 PM saw Moore East point bearing N.W. of compass at night 15 miles Dist bearing ditto took in studding sail & Middle part laying back latter at 3 AM steered up to the N.W. at 11 AM off the Passage Lat Moore

Remarks on Sunday August 16<sup>th</sup>

Came with strong Trades from the N.E. and pleasant still flying towards the Passage at 3 PM came to Anchor in 13 fathoms water Lat Moore

Remarks on Monday August 17<sup>th</sup> 1842

Commenced with light Trades fine weather at 4 PM took our anchor and sail out of the Harbour bound to Curly hee Middle part laying back latter part steered for Curly hee at 9 AM went on shore for to see by uncle Edmund Norton and behold I saw him a dead corpse who drowned himself by jumping over board

Remarks on Tuesday August 18<sup>th</sup> 1842

Commenced with light Trades fine weather at 4 PM took our anchor and sail out of the Harbour bound to Curly hee Middle part laying back latter part steered for Curly hee at 9 AM went on shore for to see by uncle Edmund Norton and behold I saw him a dead corpse who drowned himself by jumping over board
