Commences with strong
trades and rainy weather at 5 pm come on board
and steered off to the N.E. bound for Chile Middle
part light air & calms latter part ditto Lat^d 18.20.10 N.
Long^y 152.10.00 W.

Remarks on Friday 28th
Commences with light
air and calms heading to the South at 8 pm took
a light breeze from the East heading sharp by the N.E.
Middle part squally latter part ditto at 7 took strong N.E.
trades Middle part squally with rain Lat^d 18.04.10 N.
Long^y 152.10.00 W.

Remarks on Saturday 29th
Commences with strong
trades from the N.E. to East and squally rugged weather
heading sharp by the South to S.E. Middle part
squally latter part ditto heading to the N.E. Lat^d 16.39.10 N.
Long^y 152.06.00 W.

Remarks on Sunday August 30th
Commences with strong
trades from the East to N.E. and squally weather heading
sharp by the N.E. Middle part squally latter part
ditto with light rain & Lat^d 13.47.10 N.
Long^y 152.47.00 W.

Remarks on Monday Aug 31st
Commences with strong winds
from the E to N.E. and squally rugged weather heading
sharp by the S.E. to N.E. Middle part heavy squalls and
heavy rain & latter part ditto calms Lat^d 11.38.10 N.
Long^y 153.35.00 W.

Remarks on Tuesday Sept 1st
Commences with light air and
calms heading to the South Middle part heavy rain latter
part squally with much rain wind all around the
cannopuff. Lat^d 9.25.10 N.
Long^y 153.25.00 W.

Remarks on Wednesday Sept 2nd 1846
Commences with light air
and calms wind all around the cannopuff and heavy rain
Middle part calms & rains and no heading latter part ditto
squalls of rain and calms Lat^d 8.30.10 N.
Long^y 152.00.00 W.

Remarks on Thursday Sept 3rd
Commences with light air
and calms heading all around the cannopuff & Middle part squally
latter part ditto with much rain Lat^d 8.28.10 N.
Long^y 152.30.00 W.

Remarks on Friday Sept 4th
Commences with light winds from
the N.E. to South heading to the E & to East by 10 pm heading
Middle part squally heading sharp by the N & E. latter part
at 2 pm took to the S.W. Middle part moderate Lat^d 8.16.10 N.
Long^y 152.47.00 W.

Remarks on Saturday Sept 5th
Commences with light breeze
from the N.E. and pleasant weather heading sharp by the
N.E. Middle part strong breeze latter part moderate
heading from S.W. to S by 10 pm setting Lat^d 7.05.10 N.
Long^y 152.05.00 W.

Remarks on Sunday Sept 6th
Commences with moderate
trades from the N.E. and pleasant & hot weather heading
sharp by the S.W. Middle part light breeze latter part
ditto and fine weather Lat^d 6.02.10 N.
Long^y 152.47.00 W.

Remarks on Monday Sept 7th
Commences with light air
from the N.E. and fine pleasant weather heading sharp
by the S.W. to S. Middle part ditto latter part the same
at 12 o'clock a very heavy tide reef rounded with 90 fathoms
and no bottom full of fish & Lat^d 4.54.10 N.
