

Remarks on Saturday September 19th 1845

Commenced with strong breeze from the S.E. and squally weather heading sharp by the S.W. Middle part squally Latter part ditto at 11:30 a.m. saw a ship steering ~~west~~ by the wind to the South at night she was in the weather here Lat 46° 15' - 108° Long 159° 36' W.

Remarks on Sunday Sept 20

Came with strong breeze and squally heading sharp by the S.W. at night squally Middle part ditto Latter strong wind & squalls of rain at 10 a.m. spoke a French ship 350 tons Lat 46° 16' - 108° Long 160° 20' W.

Remarks on Monday Sept 21

Commenced with strong winds and from the E.S.E. and squally rugged weather heading sharp by the South by the Middle part heading S.E. Latter light on sail in sight to windward Lat 46° 19' - 105° Long 160° 01' W.

Remarks on Tuesday Sept 22

Came with light breeze from the N.E. and pleasant weather heading to the E. by the S.E. Middle part steering to the E.S.E. Latter at 8 calm and a heavy fall a running from the South Lat 46° 20' - 103° Long 159° 08' W.

Remarks on Wednesday Sept 23

Came with a light breeze from the South and squally rugged weather heading to the S.W. at 2 the wind increased to a strong gale at 7 a.m. hauled ship to the E.S.E. Middle part strong gale & squally Latter part ditto at 3 a.m. hauled ship to the S.W. Lat 46° 20' - 103° Long 159° 15' W.

Remarks on Thursday Sept 24

Came with strong gale from the S.E. and squally rainy weather heading to the S.W. under close reef Middle part squally Latter part ditto Lat 46° 21' - 103° Long 160° 01' W.

Remarks on Friday September 25th 1845

Commenced with strong winds from the E.S.E. and squally rugged weather heading to the South under short sail Middle part heavy squalls Latter part ditto Lat 46° 23' - 101° Long 160° 13' W.

Remarks on Saturday Sept 26

Commenced with strong winds from E.S.E. and squally rugged weather heading sharp by the S.W. Middle part heavy squalls with rain Latter part at 7 hauled ship to the E.S.E. Lat 46° 24' - 99° Long 160° 30' W.

Remarks on Sunday Sept 27

Commenced with strong gale from the E.S.E. and squally rainy weather heading to the N.E. at 3 p.m. hauled ship to the South Middle part heavy rain with Thunder & Lightning Middle Latter part more moderate at 6 made more sail at 10 calm Lat 46° 25' - 98° Long 161° 06' W.

Remarks on Monday Sept 28

Came with a calm heading to the South at 7 p.m. took a light breeze from the South heading to the E.S.E. Middle part strong breeze Latter part ditto heading sharp by the E.S.E. to S.E. Lat 46° 25' - 95° Long 159° 42' W.

Remarks on Tuesday Sept 29

Commenced with strong winds from the S.W. and pleasant weather heading sharp by the S.E. to S.E. Middle part ditto Latter part ditto some squally heading ditto Lat 46° 25' - 94° Long 158° 56' W.

Remarks on Wednesday Sept 30

Commenced with strong winds from the S.W. and pleasant weather heading sharp by the S.E. Middle part ditto Latter the same saw some whale birds &c Lat 46° 28' - 95° Long 158° 50' W.
