

Remarks on Tuesday October 13th 1846

Came with light breeze from the East and fine pleasant weather heading to the South Middle part light air & calm. Latter ditto ditto Lat 40° 55' S. Long 132° 00' W.

Remarks on Wednesday Oct 14

Commenced with light air from the East and pleasant weather heading to the South Middle part calm. Latter part at 7 took a light breeze South heading East. Lat 40° 18' S. Long 130° 16' W.

Remarks on Thursday Oct 15

Commenced with light air from the West and overcast weather steering to the East with all sail set. Middle part strong breeze from the NW. Latter part the wind from the NW to the SE. Lat 40° 31' S. Long 133° 30' W.

Remarks on Friday Oct 16

Came with strong winds from the NW to NW and squally weather steering to the East with all sail set at night took in the studding sails. Middle part strong gale and heavy squalls. Latter part at 7 more moderate, made sail. Lat 40° 32' S. Long 135° 50' W.

Remarks on Saturday Oct 17

Came with strong winds from the West and squally weather steering to the East at night the wind hauled to the SE. Middle part the wind hauled to the S. Latter part light air & calm. Lat 40° 40' S. Long 135° 30' W.

Remarks on Sunday Oct 18

Commenced with light air and calm at 4 p.m. took a breeze from the North heading East. Middle part strong winds. Latter part ditto with light rain and a heavy sea running from the SE. Lat 40° 42' S. Long 132° 15' W.

Remarks on Monday October 19th 1845

Commenced with strong breeze from the North and squally rainy weather heading to the East under double reef at night more moderate. Middle part strong wind. Latter ditto with light rain and light squalls. Lat 41° 33' S. Long 131° 00' W.

Remarks on Tuesday Oct 20

Commenced with strong breeze from the North and overcast weather heading to the East to E. Middle part strong winds and light squalls. Latter part ditto with rain at 10 & the wind increased. Lat 42° 10' S. Long 126° 00' W.

Remarks on Wednesday Oct 21

Commenced with a strong wind from the North and thick rainy weather heading to the East at 2 p.m. took heavy squalls from the NW. Steered to the E. under double reef at night winds from the West. Middle part ditto. Latter part strong winds & squally and a heavy sea on. Lat 41° 48' S. Long 121° 40' W.

Remarks on Thursday Oct 22

Came with a gale from the NW to NW and squally rugged weather steering to the E. with prudent sail on. Middle part strong winds & squally. Latter part ditto saw porpoises. Lat 42° 25' S. Long 117° 10' W.

Remarks on Friday Oct 23

Commenced with strong winds from the NW and squally overcast weather steering to the E. with all sail out. Middle part strong winds & squally. Latter part ditto with fog and light rain saw nothing. Lat 42° 31' S. Long 112° 51' W.
