Spence & Fox top. saw 1 ship at 8 am blowing a complete hurricane at 9 pm a ship a head 3 ships length coming into us put the whole hand up fall of 4 pm to and stop the ship. pass to weather once her length which we have reason to thank God for. Barometer down to 29.20 at 7 she began to rise and the gale abated at 9 the wind halloed to the NW. heading from NW to NE.
