

Remarks on Sunday November 22nd 1862

Commenced with strong gales from the S.W. and heavy squalls attended with hail & rain at 4 pm. At dusk began to clear up with the gale moderating. Middle part ditto latter part moderate breeze from the S.W. at 8 pm. At 10 pm. gales and squalls latter part the wind backed to the North with rain nothing but gales.

Remarks on Monday Nov 23rd

Came with strong gales from the North to West and squally rugged weather heading to the N.W. Middle part strong gales latter more moderate at 5 pm. ship to the West.

Long $77^{\circ} 05'$ W

Remarks on Tuesday Nov 24th

Came with strong winds from the South and squally rugged weather turning to the East at 4 pm. Saw Blackfish lowered and took 3 fish. 1 sail Middle part light breeze latter at day light headed ship to the East at 5 pm. 1 whale lowered without success & 2 more lowered & hoisted and steered to the East.

Remarks on Wednesday Nov 25th

Came with strong winds from the N.W. and squally rugged weather heading to the N.W. at 4 pm. Spoke the ship Circumcise nothing seen since her last Middle part strong winds & squally latter part at 5 am. saw 1 right whale lowered without success at 9 strong gales with rain.

Remarks on Thursday Nov 26th

Came with strong gales from the West and squally rainy weather heading to the South at 5 pm. Headed ship to the N.W. Middle part strong gales and heavy squalls latter part ditto blow. For top of the day.

Remarks on Friday Nov 27th 1862

Commenced with very heavy gales from the South and heavy squalls leading to much storm sails at night. At a reef fore sail Middle part strong gales and fog latter part more moderate with a heavy sea on.

Long $78^{\circ} 00'$ W

Remarks on Saturday Nov 28th

Came with strong winds from the South to N.W. and squally weather heading to the S.E. at night. Headed ship to the West. Middle part ditto latter part moderate saw four backs & 1 sail in sight.

Lat $43^{\circ} 50'$ S
Long $77^{\circ} 30'$ W

Remarks on Sunday Nov 29th

Came with strong winds in fog heading to the S.E. at 1 pm. Spoke the ship Circumcise 2000 29 months old. Middle part moderate latter part foggy at 3 pm. Headed East at 11 am spoke the bark Ship Talparina 2100 lbs so ends.

Remarks on Monday Nov 30th

Came with light breeze from the South in company with the bark T. at night. Headed ship to the S.E. Middle part ditto latter part heading to the East at 10 am. 1 whale lowered without success at 11 am. 2 more lowered struck & killed at 12 took him to the ship.

Remarks on Tuesday Dec 1st

Came with light breeze from the South and pleasant weather at 3 pm. came cutting at 6 finished very heavy sea at night heading to the N.W. Middle part ditto latter part sailing.

Long $75^{\circ} 56'$ W

Remarks on Wednesday Dec 2nd

Came with light breeze from the South and pleasant flying to the South. Saw four backs at 6 spoke the ship Aqueduct N.B. 500 lbs Middle part strong winds latter part ditto with rain heading to the S.W. sailing at.
