

Remarks on Thursday December 3rd 1846

Came with strong winds from the South and squally rugged weather heading to the S. sailing at 3 finished at night took in sail Middle part ditto latter part at 8 bore ship to the East & commenced a strong wind

Lat 43-35-30 N Long 77-22-10 W

Came with strong winds from the South and squally rugged weather heading to the East under double reef and blowing down at 5 finished and bore ship to the S. saw 1 sail Middle part strong winds latter part ditto at 7 a.m. took to the E. at 10 a.m. spoke the ship Tomson N. B. 25 months out 1100 lb

Lat 43-35-30 N Long 77-20-10 W

Came with strong winds from the South and squally rugged weather heading sharp by the E. at 4 took to the S. under double reef Middle part strong winds & squally latter part ditto at 5 a.m. bore ship to the East saw finbacks 2 sail

Lat 43-37-10 N Long 78-50-10 W

Came with strong winds from the South and squally rugged weather heading to the East under double reef at 5 bore ship to the S. Middle part strong winds latter part at 3 bore ship to the East saw 3 sails 1 ship sailing

Lat 43-54-10 N Long 78-50-10 W

Came with strong winds from the S. and squally weather heading to the E. at 1 p.m. spoke the ship Abel Merchant 900 lb Middle part heading sharp by the South latter part thick fog with rain

Lat 45-10-10 N Long 78-20-10 W

Remarks on Tuesday December 5th 1846

Came with strong breeze from the West and thick foggy weather heading to the E. at 2 p.m. saw 1 ship bore to downy fast to a whale at 5 p.m. saw two right whales towed struck (and bore the ship) in site Middle part moderate latter part squally

Lat 45-35-10 N Long 78-10-10 W

Came with a strong wind from the W. W. and squally rugged weather at 1 saw right whale towed & galled him at 7 saw 3 right whales of Deck Middle part strong winds latter foggy at 8 a.m. saw right whale towed without success so bore 9 sails in site

Lat 45-42-10 N Long 78-30-10 W

Came with light winds from the West and a heavy sail saw some scattering whales and very wild at 8 p.m. spoke the ship Fabius N. B. 5 weeks latter part calm latter light breeze at 5 a.m. saw 1 right whale towed and galled to back in chase

Lat 45-43-10 N Long 78-50-10 W

Came with light breeze from the South and foggy saw some whale at 1 killed one and took him to the ship Middle part sailing latter part ditto at day light saw more whale Corp in chase so bore with 9 sails in site

Lat 45-38-10 N Long 78-40-10 W

Came with light breeze from the South and thick hazy weather saw right whale at 1 p.m. took one to the ship and came cutting at 3 finished Middle part sailing latter part ditto with several whales in site and a plenty of ships

Lat 45-35-10 N Long 78-31-10 W
