

Remarks on Sunday December 13th

Coming with light air from the South and thick hazy weather flying to the South sailing Middle part ditto Latter at day light by 10 saw 1 whale lowered and lost his side 9 mile in sight and 4 of them

Latt 45-29 S.
Long 75-42 W.

Remarks on Monday Dec 14

Coming with light breeze from the SE and pleasant weather heading sharp of the SE sailing Middle part ditto Latter part at 7 took to the SE at 9 spoke the bark with of green port 2 whale Latt 45-25 S.

Long 76-42 W.

Remarks on Tuesday Dec 15

Coming with light breeze from the South and over cast heading to the E. at 3 pm saw right whale lowered without success at 5 spoke the ship. Mile N. 5 W. month and 2 whales and the ship Columbus N. Lon. 3 whale this season Middle part heading to the South Latter part saw right whale lowered could not strike Latt 46-06 S.

Long 77-25 W.

Remarks on Wednesday Dec 16

Coming with light air and calms heading to the South Eup. in stormy downy and in chase of whales but to wild Middle part Calm Latter part ditto at 11 saw right whale lowered on board Latt 46-20 S.

Long 77-10 W.

Remarks on Thursday Dec 17

Coming with light air and calms Eup. in stormy downy at 6 finished saw 3 sails and 1 a cutting Middle part Calm Latter part foggy saw timber at 11 spoke the ship Curawan of Fall River 13 months out 50 lbs so back with fog

Latt 46-15 S.
Long 76-40 W.

Remarks on Friday December 18th 1845

Coming with light air from the SE and foggy at 11 pm saw a Dead whale at 2 spoke him to the ship and made ready for cutting at 8 finished and commenced hauling 2 mile in sight Middle part sailing Latter part saw 9 sails at 10 saw 7 right whale lowered struck him and drew the line Latt 45-48 S.

Long 75-20 W.

Remarks on Saturday Dec 19th

Coming with strong breeze from the South and over cast heading to the SE with all sail set at 7 finished hauling Middle part under short sail Latter part at 7 commenced hauling at 11 finished so back 5 mile in sight Latt 45-26 S.

Long 75-50 W.

Remarks on Sunday Dec 20

Coming with strong winds from the South and foggy weather heading to the SE at 4 lowered ship to the W. at 7 spoke the ship Cornaday 50 barrels Middle part under short sail Latter made all sail saw timber at 7 spoke the ship Gen Scott 1900 Slight white Latt 46-00 S.

Long 76-25 W.

Remarks on Monday Dec 21

Coming with strong breeze from the SE and over cast heading to the SE at 7 saw 2 right whale to back for to lower 7 mile in sight Middle part heading to the South Latter at 8 am saw right whale lowered struck killed him at 7 took him to the ship Latt 47-05 S.

Long 76-30 W.

Remarks on Tuesday Dec 22

Coming with strong breeze from the W. and rugged at 1 pm saw more whales lowered at 2 spoke struck at 5 spoke him turned up 3 miles towards with his forehook unjinted at 6 spoke him to the ship and commenced hauling Middle part ditto Latter part at 7 commenced hauling at 11 finished
