 Coming with light breeze
 from the South East in working the ship up the bay
 at 3 p.m. came to anchor in 8 fathoms water

Remarks on Friday February 19th
 Coming with strong breeze
 from the South Middle part calm latter part strong
 breeze from the South at 10 a.m. took our anchor and
 steered out of the bay at 11 p.m. and side of Rarrikena

Remarks on Thursday Feb 18th
 Coming with strong winds from
 the South and rugged weather steering to the N.W. Middle
 part strong winds and squally latter part steering
 to the N.W. saw sulphur bottomed &c. Lat 44° 33' N. Long 175° 35' W.

Remarks on Friday Feb 19th
 Coming with strong winds from
 the S.E. and rugged weather steering to the N.W. Middle
 part strong winds latter part heavy rain. Lat 44° 31' N. Long 176° 00' W.

Remarks on Saturday Feb 20th
 Coming with strong trades from
 the S.E. and rugged weather steering to the N.W. saw blackfish
 & Middle part steering ditto latter at the same Lat 44° 50' N. Long 176° 25' W.

Remarks on Sunday Feb 21st
 Coming with strong trades
 from the S.E. and over cast steering to the N.W. at 2 p.m.
 saw a shoal of sperm whales at 3 a.m. and the boat
 steared mist the whale chased until 11 p.m. could not
 get on Middle part steering to the N.W. latter part
 at 8 steering to the N.E. saw porpoise &c. Lat 44° 54' N. Long 177° 20' W.

Remarks on Monday February 22nd 1847
 Commenced with strong
 trades from the S.E. and over cast weather steering to the
 N.E. saw Porpoise & Middle part strong trades latter part
 steering to the N.W. Lat 44° 54' N. Long 177° 40' W.

Remarks on Tuesday Feb 23rd
 Coming with strong trade from
 the S.E. and over cast steering to the North Middle
 part ditto latter part fine pleasant weather Comp. in
 painting the boat &c. Lat 44° 22' N. Long 178° 00' W.

Remarks on Wednesday Feb 24th
 Coming with light air and calm
 steering to the N.W. Middle part ditto latter light air
 nothing in sight Lat 44° 20' N. Long 178° 40' W.

Remarks on Thursday Feb 25th
 Coming with light breeze from
 the S.E. and pleasant weather heading to the N.W. Middle
 part light air & calm latter ditto Lat 44° 20' N. Long 178° 05' W.

Remarks on Friday Feb 26th
 Coming with light air from the
 S.E. and fine pleasant weather steering to the N.W. at 2 p.m.
 saw blackfish got 2 Middle part light air & calm
 latter part light trades and pleasant Lat 44° 19' N. Long 178° 02' W.

Remarks on Saturday Feb 27th
 Coming with light trades from
 the S.E. and fine pleasant weather steering to the N.W.
 at night set the rigals Middle part ditto latter part
 steering North saw birds fish &c. Lat 44° 16' N. Long 178° 50' W.
