

## Remarks on Friday March 13<sup>th</sup> 1847

Commences with light trade from the S.E. and fine pleasant weather steering to the N.W. at 3 pm saw a sail at 4 pm spoke the ship *America* of New York at 18 months out 400 tons. Spoke at 5 pm. Sailed just. Middle part ditto latter the same saw killer porpoise & at 10 got blooded in. Lat  $40^{\circ} 30' 36''$  Long  $72^{\circ} 25' 10''$

## Remarks on Saturday March 13<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light trade from the S.E. and squally weather steering to the N.W. with all sail set saw porpoises & Middle part ditto latter fine weather and hot. Lat  $40^{\circ} 30' 54''$  Long  $74^{\circ} 30' 10''$

## Remarks on Sunday March 14<sup>th</sup>

Come with light trade from the S.E. and fine pleasant weather steering to the west saw black fish porpoise cow fish & Middle part great number of black fish & latter squally with light rain. Lat  $40^{\circ} 20' 58''$  Long  $75^{\circ} 23'$

## Remarks on Monday March 15<sup>th</sup>

Come with light trade from the E. to S.E. and pleasant steering to the west saw porpoise fish & Middle part light air latter part light breeze and squally rain slow getting along. Lat  $40^{\circ} 30' 55''$  Long  $78^{\circ} 13' 10''$

## Remarks on Tuesday March 15<sup>th</sup>

Come with light air and calm steering to the west saw porpoise fish & Middle part calm latter part light air & calm. Lat  $40^{\circ} 20' 58''$  Long  $79^{\circ} 24' 10''$

## Remarks on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light air and calm heading to the west to the N.W. saw fish a strong current setting to the S.E. Middle part calm latter ditto with rain at 10 more pleasant. Lat  $40^{\circ} 30' 11''$  Long  $78^{\circ} 17' 10''$

## Remarks on Thursday March 15<sup>th</sup> 1847

Commences with light air from the South and fine pleasant weather heading to the west but slow headway and no mistake Middle part heavy rain latter at 9 more pleasant. Lat  $40^{\circ} 30' 36''$  Long  $78^{\circ} 10' 26''$

## Remarks on Friday March 19<sup>th</sup>

Come with light breeze from the South and pleasant weather steering to the west Middle part ditto latter part at 4 heavy rain. Lat  $40^{\circ} 30' 54''$  Long  $76^{\circ} 05' 10''$

## Remarks on Saturday March 20<sup>th</sup>

Come with light air from the S.E. and pleasant steering to the N.W. saw white whales & Middle part light air and calm latter ditto with rain and a strong current setting to the North. Lat  $40^{\circ} 20' 58''$  Long  $78^{\circ} 05' 10''$

## Remarks on Sunday March 21<sup>st</sup>

Commences with light air from the South and squally rainy weather steering to the N.W. Middle part ditto latter part at 7 started to the N.W. at 8 the wind shifted to the N.W. heading to the west. Middle part calm with light air. Lat  $40^{\circ} 10' 58''$  Long  $78^{\circ} 14' 10''$

## Remarks on Monday March 22<sup>nd</sup>

Commences with light air and calm heading to the N.W. to west Middle part ditto latter part calm and light air. Lat  $40^{\circ} 20' 58''$  Long  $78^{\circ} 23' 10''$

## Remarks on Tuesday March 23<sup>rd</sup>

Come with light air from the South and fine pleasant weather steering to the N.W. with all sail set saw porpoise black fish cow fish and 8 heavy ground to day Middle part light air and pleasant latter overcast saw breakers but saw no whales. Lat  $40^{\circ} 30' 11''$  Long  $78^{\circ} 39'$
