

Remarks on Friday April 16th 1847

Came with light breeze from the East and thick overcast weather heading on to the South at Night East point bore South Dist 32 miles West point of Mani bore W by S Dist 32 miles & 11/2 m. bore South the middle point of the latter part at 4 a.m. kept off to the S. at 9 a.m. saw the Shipping and I went on shore far to procure recruits at 12 Meridian they are all off 3 boats loaded in about one and a half hour Mani

Remarks on Saturday April 17

Came with fine breeze lying off & on at 3 p.m. came on board and steered down the Channel Middle part of the West point of Molici Calm latter at 2 took a light breeze from the N.E. Steered to the West at 12 the West point of Carhu bore N.W. Dist 5 miles

Long 158.04 W.

Remarks on Sunday April 18

Came with a light breeze from the N.W. and fine pleasant weather heading S.W. by the N.W. to the N.W. at Night the North point of Carhu bore N.W. Dist 5 Leagues. At 7 P.M. took the Strong N.E. trades heading to the N.W. Middle part ditto latter part squally heading ditto

Remarks on Monday April 19

Came with Strong trades from the N.E. and squally weather heading sharp by the N.W. Middle part squally latter part ditto heading to the N.W. to the N.W. So came with rugged weather

Lat 25.19 N.

Long 159.58 W.

Remarks on Tuesday April 20

Came with Strong trades from the N.E. and squally rugged weather heading sharp by the N.W. Middle part Strong winds latter part moderate at 2 1/2 light saw a sail 4 points on the horizon

Remarks on Wednesday April 21st 1847

Came with light breeze from the N.E. and squally weather heading to the N.W. to the N.W. Sail in sight Middle part light air latter ditto almost calm heading sharp by the N.W. to the N.W.

Remarks on Thursday April 22

Came with light air from the N.W. and fine pleasant weather heading sharp by the N.W. at 1 p.m. spoke the Ship Benjamin Morgan Middle part heading ditto latter at 7 a.m. took a light breeze from the East Steering to the N.W. saw two more sail

Lat 29.25 W.

Long 162.20 W.

Remarks on Friday April 23

Came with light breeze from the South and fine pleasant weather Steering to the N.W. in company with the above men ship Middle part Steering ditto latter part the wind hauled to the N.W. increasing to a gale Steering N.W. to N.W. on sail in sight

Lat 32.25 N.

Long 162.45 W.

Remarks on Saturday April 24

Came with Strong winds or gale from the West and thick foggy rainy weather Steering to the N.W. at 4 the wind hauled to the N.W. heading sharp by the N.W. Middle part strong winds & squally latter more moderate at 9 a.m. heard ships to the N.W. on sail in sight

Long 162.04 W.

Remarks on Sunday April 25

Came with light air and Calm heading to the N.W. with a heavy sail Middle part light air latter took a light breeze from the South Steering to the N.W. in company with the above ship

Lat 32.44 N.

Remarks on Monday April 26

Came with light breeze from the South and pleasant Steering to the N.W. Middle part ditto latter part strong breeze and overcast

Lat 34.06 N.
