

Remarks on Tuesday April 27th 1847

Came with strong breeze from the North and thick over cast steering to the NW by N. with all sail set still in company with the larger vessel. Middle part strong breeze and squally latter part light air and calm. Took a haul from the NW with rain. Lat 35.45 N. Long 162.28 W.

Remarks on Wednesday April 28th

Came with strong winds from the NW to NE and squally rainy weather heading sharp by the ENE. At 1 pm took to the NW at 2 pm took strong squalls in coming to a gale from the North Middle part strong winds & squally latter part ditto same. 1 sail to land. Lat 36.12 N. Long 166.35 W.

Remarks on Thursday April 29th

Came with strong winds from the North and squally rugged weather heading sharp by the NW with the wind more moderate. Middle part squally latter part ditto flying to the windward. Lat 35.28 N. Long 165.40 W.

Remarks on Friday April 30th

Came with strong winds from the North and squally rugged weather heading to the west. At 2 pm took to the NE. At night heading to the NE. Middle part light breeze latter part light air and calm. At 10 am saw a right whale a leaping at 11 am lowered 3 boat struck killed and hauled him back again and no mistake. Lat 38.56 N. Long 164.39 W.

Remarks on Saturday May 1st

Came with light air from the SW and over cast steering to the NW. Saw birds & Middle part heavy squalls wind all around latter light air & calm with a heavy sea. Lat 38.42 N. Long 164.14 W.

Remarks on Sunday May 2nd 1847

Came with light air and calm heading to the west. At 2 pm took a strong wind from the North attended with rain and hail. Saw finbacks and a great number of species of birds & whale heads. Middle part squally with a heavy sea latter ditto. Lat 39.55 N. Long 163.14 W.

Remarks on Monday May 3rd 1847

Came with strong winds from the ENE to East and squally thick weather steering to the NW. Saw finbacks whale birds & Middle part strong winds & squally latter part ditto of the fog and squally weather. Lat 42.12 N. Long 166.15 W.

Remarks on Tuesday May 4th

Came with strong Gale from the North and squally rainy weather heading to the NW by W. under short sail. Middle part ditto strong Gale in heavy squalls latter much the same with rain. Lat 43.30 N. Long 167.10 W.

Remarks on Wednesday May 5th

Came with strong Gale from the North and squally rainy weather heading to the NW under short sail. Flying to under storm sails. Middle part strong Gale and heavy squalls latter part ditto at 9 am more moderate. At 8 o'clock ship to the NE. Lat 43.10 N. Long 167.40 W.

Remarks on Thursday May 6th

Came with strong Gale from the NW and squally rugged weather heading to the NE under short sail. Middle part squally latter more moderate at 4 set all sail heading to the west. Lat 43.37 N. Long 168.19 W.

Remarks on Friday May 7th

Came with light breeze from the NW and pleasant weather heading to the NE. Saw black finbacks & Middle part light air & calm. Latter 10 am took a light air from the NE steering to the North. Lat 46.50 N. Long 168.25 W.
