

Remarks on Saturday May 8th 47

Came with moderate breeze from the NW and thick foggy weather steering to the North with all sail set. at night the wind hauled to the NW. Middle part strong winds & squally. Latter ditto. Lat 48° 28' N. Long 155° 45' W.

Remarks on Sunday May 9th 47

Came with light air from the NW and pleasant weather heading sharp by the NW & at night lowest Calms Middle part took a breeze from the NW steering to the NW by N. Lat 48° 16' N. Long 158° 42' W.

Remarks on Monday May 10

Came with strong winds from South and pleasant weather steering to the NW by N. saw birds for the first time. Middle part strong winds and squally with rain. Latter ditto at 8 am saw 2 light whales close to the ship. Lay to and took in sail. Lat 48° 20' N. Long 158° 02' W.

Remarks on Tuesday May 11

Came with strong winds from the South and thick foggy weather heading to the West to 10 by S at night the wind hauled to the West saw for the first time. at night took in sail and heaved ship to the NW. Middle part strong winds & squally. Latter ditto at 4 am heaved ship to the NW & saw for the first time. Lat 48° 50' N. Long 158° 17' W.

Remarks on Wednesday May 12

Came with strong winds from the NW and squally rugged weather heading sharp by the NW & to N & under double reef, to gain run with the land. Middle part strong winds & squally. Latter part at 1 am tack to the NW & saw for the first time. Lat 48° 51' N. Long 158° 45' W.

Remarks on Thursday May 13th 47

Commenced with strong winds from the NW and thick foggy rainy weather at 1 am tack to the NW & at night took up sails of. saw for the first time. Middle part strong winds & squally. Latter ditto at 4 am took a light breeze from the NW & heading sharp by the NW. at 8 am saw a light whale lowered and got him. Lat 48° 28' N. Long 156° 26' W.

Remarks on Friday May 14

Came with moderate breeze from the NW heading sharp by the North with all sail set. with fog and light rain at 4 am tack to the NW by S. Middle part strong wind and squally. Latter part at 1 am heft of. to the East. at 8 am saw great number of forbsacks and birds. Lat 48° 51' N. Long 154° 50' W.

Remarks on Saturday May 15

Came with strong winds from the West and squally foggy weather steering to the East. saw for the first time. at 4 am saw a bird at 5 pm spoke the Metacom 1700 lbs sent out at night more moderate. Middle part heading to the West. Latter at 8 heaved ship to the East. saw for the first time. Lat 48° 51' N. Long 154° 10' W.

Remarks on Sunday May 16

Came with light air from the East and pleasant weather steering to the NW & in company with the above men ship at night took in sail. Middle part steering to the East. Latter heading to the North at 5 am saw 1 light whale 2 miles off. at 6 lowered it & I boat & took killed at 8 took him to the ship and made ready for counting at 12 finished and heaved ship to the NW. Lat 48° 51' N. Long 152° 45' W.

Remarks on Monday May 17

Came with moderate breeze from North and overcast heading sharp by the NW & backing at 10 pm the wind increased to a gale. Middle part strong gale. Latter ditto with a heavy sea rolling from the East. one sail in air. Lat 48° 51' N. Long 152° 45' W.
