

Remarks on Monday July 5th 1847

Came with light breeze and pleasant weather. Camp in cutting at 6th finished took in sail and came bailing. Middle part rainy. Latter foggy at 8 a.m. saw right whale to thick for to lower.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 50' N$
 Long $155^{\circ} 30' W$

Remarks on Tuesday July 6th

Came with strong winds from the NW and thick foggy weather heading to the SE at 1 p.m. secured ship to the NW. saw finbacks & Camp bailing. Middle part strong winds and hazy. Latter with fog. saw finbacks &
 Lat $46^{\circ} 50' - 18' N$
 Long $158^{\circ} 53' W$

Remarks on Wednesday July 7th

Came with a gale from the NW and rough weather heading to the NW. under short sail bailing. Middle part ditto. Latter more moderate at 6 p.m. secured ship to the NW. bailing & strong down.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 50' - 50' N$
 Long $153^{\circ} 12' W$

Remarks on Thursday July 8th

Came with strong winds from the NW and thick foggy weather heading to the NW. bailing & strong down in the after hole. Middle part strong winds and squally. Latter thick fog. Camp in strong down.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 50' - 10' N$
 Long $152^{\circ} 20' W$

Remarks on Friday July 9th

Came with strong winds from the NW and thick foggy weather heading to the NW. bailing & strong down at 5 p.m. finished and secured ship to the NW. Middle part strong winds and thick fog. Latter ditto with rain at 10 heading to the NW.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 50' - 15' N$
 Long $152^{\circ} 40' W$

Remarks on Saturday July 10th

Came with strong winds from the NW and squally foggy weather heading to the NW. at 7 p.m. secured ship to the NW. Middle part strong winds. Latter ditto with fog at 9 p.m. double reefed saw finback.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 50' - 10' N$
 Long $154^{\circ} 58' W$

Remarks on Sunday July 11th 1847

Came with strong winds from the NW and foggy heavy weather heading to the NW. at 7 p.m. secured ship to the NW. Middle part strong winds. Latter part strong winds inclining to a gale at 10 p.m. secured ship heading to NW with a thick fog as usual bound to the NW.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 50' - 30' N$
 Long $156^{\circ} 20' W$

Remarks on Monday July 12th

Came with strong winds from the NW and squally foggy weather steering to the North with all prudent sail set. Middle part thick fog. Latter ditto at 10 p.m. saw great number of whale birds.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 52' - 53' N$
 Long $153^{\circ} 20' W$

Remarks on Tuesday July 13th

Came with strong winds from the NW and pleasant weather steering to the NW with all sail set. saw birds & Middle part light air and calm. Latter ditto with thick fog & rain. At 6 took a light breeze from the South.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 54' - 05' N$
 Long $152^{\circ} 00' W$

Remarks on Wednesday July 14th

Came with light breeze from the South and thick fog and rain steering to the SE with all sail set. saw some whale food. Middle part strong winds. Latter part ditto with thick fog & rain.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 55' - 10' N$
 Long $148^{\circ} 00' W$

Remarks on Thursday July 15th

Came with strong winds from the NW and thick fog steering to the SE at 2 p.m. saw no sail at 4 p.m. spoke the ship Comnada & whale. Middle part heading to the SE. Latter steered to the SE.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 54' - 55' N$
 Long $147^{\circ} 14' W$

Remarks on Friday July 16th

Came with strong winds from the NW and thick foggy weather steering to the SE. saw finbacks, sail in sight. Middle part strong winds. Latter part ditto at 11 a.m. spoke the Comnada and heard a gun.
 Lat $46^{\circ} 53' - 11' N$
 Long $146^{\circ} 10' W$
