

Remarks on ~~Saturday~~ Sunday July 17<sup>th</sup> 1847

Came with strong winds from the SW and thick fog steering to the NE in company with the Canada at 5 pm saw a sail at night thick fog. Middle put Logy back. Latt's heading to the E. S. Lat. 4. 51. 40 N. Long. 146. 00 W.

Remarks on ~~Sunday~~ Monday July 18<sup>th</sup>

Came with strong winds from the SW and thick foggy rainy weather heading to the E. S. under double reef. Middle put strong winds and heavy rain. Latt at 8 more clear sun. 1 pm back. Lat. 4. 51. 40 N. Long. 146. 59 W.

Remarks on Monday July 19<sup>th</sup>

Came with light breeze from the SW and foggy weather steering to the East with all sail set. at 1 pm hauled around sharp by the W. N. Bound. on our old ground again. Middle put strong winds and fog. Latt's part ditto at 10 more clear. Lat. 4. 52. 40 N. Long. 146. 04 W.

Remarks on Tuesday July 20<sup>th</sup>

Came with strong winds from the South and thick foggy weather as usual heading sharp by the W. S. with all sail set. Middle put strong winds and foggy. Latt's ditto with a very heavy feel rolling from the SW. saw. put back 8 birds. Lat. 4. 52. 41 N. Long. 150. 00 W.

Remarks on Wednesday July 21<sup>st</sup>

Came with strong winds from the S. S. and foggy weather heading sharp by the S. W. L. to SW. Middle put heading to the W. Latt's thick heavy with steering to the SW. saw course SW. Lat. 4. 50. 55 N. Long. 152. 20 W.

Remarks on Thursday July 22<sup>nd</sup>

Came with strong winds from the E. S. and equally foggy weather steering to the SW under double reef, saw put back 7. At night the wind hauled to the South. Latt's part foggy heading to the W. W. at 7 back to the S. Lat. 4. 50. 40 N. Long. 156. 10 W.

Remarks on Friday July 23<sup>rd</sup> 1847

Came with strong winds from the SW and thick foggy rugged weather heading to the S. P. E. at 4 pm hauled ship to the W. N. saw. put back birds & Middle put heading to the W. Latt's at 7 steering to the W. at 12 wind hauled ship to the S. Lat. 4. 51. 13 N. Long. 155. 35 W.

Remarks on Saturday July 24<sup>th</sup>

Came with strong winds from the SW and foggy weather heading sharp by the S. E. with all sail set. saw. nothing. Middle put strong winds. Latt's ditto with thick fog saw birds and some fish. Lat. 4. 50. 40 N. Long. 152. 40 W.

Remarks on Sunday July 25<sup>th</sup>

Came with strong winds from the South to SW and thick fog, several heading by the wind to the E. N. E. Middle put ditto Latt's steering to the S. E. saw plenty of birds and saw fish and put back 8. Lat. 4. 50. 59 N. Long. 148. 45 W.

Remarks on Monday July 26<sup>th</sup>

Came with strong winds from the South and thick foggy weather steering to the N. W. E. 2 pm to East. Variation with all sail set at 2 pm saw and put a dead whale dead a long time. Middle put strong winds. Latt's more moderate and fog as usual. Lat. 4. 51. 32 N. Long. 143. 20 W.

Remarks on Tuesday July 27<sup>th</sup>

Came with light breeze from the S. E. and pleasant weather for the first day for a long time steering to the E. N. E. with all sail set. saw nothing to night saw the sun set I believe the first for 6 days. Middle put light air and pleasant. Latt's ditto at 6 pm saw a light whale going quick to the North at 7 lowered with no success. at 10 came on board steered to the E. N. E. Lat. 4. 52. 11 N. Long. 142. 07 W.
