

Remarks on Saturday August 7th

Came with strong winds from the NW and rugged squally foggy weather heading to the NW. Saw the Alexander manure at 7 pm spoke her & sent letters. She could not stand any more. At 10 pm spoke her & sent letters to the NW at 10 pm & sailed at 11 pm & lighted the lanterns and galled them with the ship.

Long 158° 13' 10" W.

Remarks on Sunday August 8th

Came with strong winds from the west and thick squally rugged weather heading sharp by the NW. At 3 pm saw a bank of ships & McDole put heading to the North. Latta at 5 took to the NW. Saw 2 seals and 1 light whale going quick to the NW.

Long 158° 09' 00" W.

Remarks on Monday August 9th

Came with strong winds from the NW and pleasant weather heading to the NW. 2 seals on side of ship. Saw a black fish & McDole put ditto. Latta at 6 took to the NW & at 9 am saw a light whale at 10 landed. In fact, in pursuit of the whale.

Lat 41° 53' 05" N.
Long 158° 05' 00" W.

Remarks on Tuesday August 10th

Came with light breeze from the NW and pleasant weather at 2 pm struck the shore. Men whale killed at 6 took him to the ship and made ready for the cut. Took 1 lip & head and lashed down for the night. McDole put Latta by the whale. Latta at 6 came cutting at 11 spoke the Enphreter 2200 lbs at 12 finished cutting.

Remarks on Wednesday August 11th

Came with strong winds from the SE and squally weather steering to the west. Boiling. McDole put heavy. Latta put more pleasant at 11 am saw a light whale and saw a ship a boiling.

Remarks on Thursday August 12 1847

Came with light breeze from the NW and overcast weather at 1 pm landed for the whale and galls him at 2 pm spoke the ship Canton 1000 lbs & 400 lb. At night heading to the SE. Boiling. Latta put at 6 took to the NW. Saw 2 seals and 1 light whale.

Long 141° 15' 00" W.

Remarks on Friday August 13th

Came with strong winds from the SE and squally heavy weather steering to the west with all sail set sailing with a heavy sea a running. At night took in sail. McDole put strong gale and rainy squally weather. Latta put ditto with rain fog.

Lat 41° 53' 16" N.
Long 142° 30' 00" W.

Remarks on Saturday August 14th

Came with strong gale from the SE and squally rugged weather with rain heading to the South. Boiling at night for moderate. McDole put almost. Calm with a heavy sea. Saw 2 light whales at night for day. Latta at 6 am moved ship heading N. W.

Lat 41° 53' 44" N.
Long 143° 40' 00" W.

Remarks on Sunday August 15th

Came with light breeze from the SE and overcast heading to the NW. Strong down at night took in sail heading NW. McDole put thick fog. Latta ditto at 8 am clear at 10 spoke the ship. Vesper New London & whale. 500 Spinn. Comp. Strong down.

Lat 41° 53' 06" N.
Long 146° 02' 00" W.

Remarks on Monday August 16th

Came with strong winds from the SE and pleasant weather steering to the west with all sail set. McDole put strong winds (no squally). Latta ditto with a heavy sea a running from the west. Saw 2 seals & 1 light whale in strong down.

Long 147° 10' 00" W.
