

Remarks on Thursday Sept 9<sup>th</sup> 1847

Commenced with light air from the S.E. to East and overcast heading to the N.W. to within Middle part. Calm latter with light air and calm

Remarks on Friday Sept 10

Came with light air from the S.E. and fine weather heading to the South & westward at 11, at calm Middle part heading to the S.E. Latter date

Lat 40° 25' N

Long 155° 22' W

Remarks on Saturday Sept 11

Commenced with light breeze from the S.W. and fine pleasant weather heading sharp by the S.E. with all sail set. Middle part ditto Latter made from the S.W. Employed in washing ship

Lat 38° 53' N

Long 155° 42' W

Remarks on Sunday Sept 12

Commenced with light breeze from the North to S.W. and equally rainy weather heading to the S.W. with all sail set Middle part ditto Latter fine pleasant weather Middle to End

Lat 37° 29' N

Remarks on Monday Sept 13

Came with light air from the South and fine pleasant weather heading to the S.W. Middle part calm Latter ditto with light air

Lat 38° 10' N

Long 155° 30' W

Remarks on Tuesday Sept 14

Came with light air from the South and fine pleasant weather heading to the S.E. Middle part ditto Latter part heading to the South

Lat 36° 58' N

Remarks on Wednesday Sept 15

Commenced with light breeze from the S.W. and fine pleasant weather heading to the S.E. Middle part ditto Latter fine pleasant weather and hot flying to the South

Lat 35° 40' N

Remarks on Thursday Sept 15 1847

Came with light air from the South to S.W. and fine pleasant weather heading to the S.E. with all sail set. Called all hands aft to find out where the Horses were bound. It proved to be one Richard Sacket which I put in the baggage and gave him 23 dashes and then he would not eat and I put him to make another one Middle part light air & calm Latter part ditto with hot weather

Remarks on Friday Sept 17

Came with light breeze from the West and fine pleasant weather heading to the South with all possible sail set. Middle part ditto Latter the same at 8 saw a sail of the sea quarter at 11 saw one on the weather beam

Lat 33° 57' N

Long 152° 23' W

Remarks on Saturday 18

Came with moderate breeze from the West and pleasant weather heading to the S.E. with all possible sail set. Middle part ditto Latter at 8 took squalls of rain and the wind hauled to the North. Steered South and set the Studding sails

Lat 30° 30' N

Long 151° 50' W

Remarks on Sunday Sept 19

Came with strong wind from the North and squally weather steering to the S.E. with all sail set. Middle part ditto Latter part more pleasant wind from North to N.E. with squalls on sail in situ

Lat 28° 04' N

Long 151° 45' W

Remarks on Monday Sept 20

Came with light breeze from the N.E. and pleasant weather steering to the South at 2 pm spoke the Ship Solomon Sables of Fairview full 2 cables Middle part heavy ditto Latter at 7 took the wind from the South with squalls of rain at 10 a.m. round all around the compass
