fish, porpoise & No whale with hot weather Lat^d 4th 10.26 S

Morning with light breeze from
the SE and squally rainy weather heading sharp to the
SE Middle part squally latter pleasant Lat^d 4th 11.58 S
Long^y 157.05 W

Remarks on Saturday Nov 6th
Morning with light air and
calms heading to the South with hot weather Middle part
part light air latter part light air and calm Lat^d 4th 12.58 S
Long^y 157.10 W

Remarks on Sunday Nov 7th
Morning with light air from
all round and squalls of rain at 5 pm took heavy squalls
from the SE attended with rain thunder & lightning
Middle part strong winds and rugged latter with
squalls of rain heading from SE to N. Lat^d 4th 14.26 S
