

Remarks on Tuesday January 25th 1848.

Commenced with strong winds from the NW and squally rugged weather. Steering to the E. N. at night took in sail. Middle part strong and latter light air & calm. Lat^d 37° 45' S. Long^d 41° 44' W.

Remarks on Wednesday Jan 26.

Commenced with light breeze from the South and hazy weather. Steering to the E. N. E. saw porpoise. Middle part strong with latter the same at 10 a.m. spoke the bark ship bearingly of west part. 140 lbs on board. Lat^d 38° 32' S. Long^d 42° 49' W.

Remarks on Thursday Jan 27.

Came with strong breeze from the E. N. E. and fine weather heading to the S. E. in company with the bark. Middle part moderate. Latter part strong breeze from the E. N. E. saw porpoise & Grampuses & Lat^d 35° 22' S. Long^d 46° 30' W.

Remarks on Friday Jan 28.

Came with strong breeze from the E. N. E. and thick overcast heading to the NW at 3 p.m. tack to the S. E. N. E. Middle part light winds latter strong breeze at 5 o'clock to the N. E. with heavy rain & Lat^d 35° 10' S. Long^d 45° 20' W.

Remarks on Saturday Jan 29.

Came with light breeze from the N. E. and thick overcast heading to the NW at 2 p.m. tack to the S. E. N. E. at night heading to the E. N. E. Middle part calm latter ditto with thick fog. Lat^d 35° 05' S. Long^d 46° 40' W.

Remarks on Sunday Jan 30.

Came with light air & calm heading round & round with thick fog at night more clear. Middle part light air & calm latter thick overcast at 8 took a light breeze from the N. E. Lat^d 35° 02' S. Long^d 46° 55' W.

Remarks on Monday January 31st 1848.

Commenced with light breeze from the N. E. and thick overcast steering to the E. N. at 3 p.m. took heavy squalls & winded with heavy thunder and sharp lightning and much rain at night calm. Middle part light breeze from the N. E. at 11 p.m. squally heading sharp by the E. N. E. Lat^d 34° 35' S. Long^d 42° 40' W.

Remarks on Tuesday February 1st.

Commenced with strong breeze from the S. E. and squally weather heading to the N. E. E. to E. N. E. with all sail set. Middle part strong breeze latter at 5 a.m. tack to the S. E. saw porpoise & Lat^d 34° 18' S. Long^d 41° 38' W.

Remarks on Wednesday Feb 2.

Commenced with light breeze from the E. N. E. and pleasant weather heading to the S. E. N. E. Middle part light air & calm latter part ditto saw Grampuses and 1 took and caught him. Lat^d 35° 02' S. Long^d 41° 32' W.

Remarks on Thursday Feb 3rd.

Commenced with light air & calm heading to the East. Middle part light breeze from the west. Latter calm. Lat^d 35° 03' S. Long^d 40° 49' W.

Remarks on Friday Feb 4.

Came with light air & calm heading to the N. E. saw porpoise. Middle part moderate breeze latter strong winds from the East. Latter heading sharp by the N. E. E. Lat^d 33° 20' S. Long^d 45° 45' W.

Remarks on Saturday Feb 5.

Commenced with strong winds from the East to South and squally rugged weather steering to the E. N. E. saw porpoise & took a part. Strong winds from the NW saw 1 porpoise heading to the west. Lat^d 32° 22' S. Long^d 38° 12' W.
