38. Friday March 28th Commenced with light breezes
C. E. N. E. and heavy steering S. W. saw pinbacks.
Sunset shortness sail Noon Lat^o 18 02 N. Long 24 11

39. Saturday March 29th Commenced with fresh breezes
C. E. N. E. steering S. W. saw a steamship steering S. W.
Later part saw the Island of St. Vincent one of
the Cape Verde's bearing N. E. W. Noon Lat^o 17 07 Long 24 43

40. Sunday March 30th Commenced with fresh breezes
C. N. E. and heavy C. 2 P. M. run down between St. Vincent
and St. Lucia. Sunset took in sail and haul by
the wind to E. S. E. daylight made sail kept of S. saw
the land the Island of Fogo haul to E. S. E. for St. Fago
C. N. W. M. wore ship to N. W. headed for Fogo
Noon Lat^o 16 20 Long 24 20

41. Monday March 31st Commenced with fresh breezes
C. N. E. steering S. W. sunset Fogo bore N. E. distant
10 miles Drags bore N. W. Noon Lat^o 14 54 Long

42. Tuesday April 1st Commenced with fresh breezes
and heavy daylight. Drags distant 5 miles to the N. E.
at 9 A. M. the Capt. left for shore to ship 3 men
sailed with light airs. Noon 14 43 N.

43. Wednesday April 2nd Commenced laying off and on
the Island of Drags off the boat returned ship's
3 Portuguese haul to N. W. Later part the same
employed in ship duty Noon 14 49 Long 24 50

44. Thursday April 3rd Commenced with light breezes
C. E. N. E. heading by the wind to the N. nothing in sight
employed in ship duty Noon Lat^o 15 41

45. Friday April 4th Commenced with fresh breezes
and pleasant heading to the N. W. by the wind
employed in ship duty Noon 17 16 N. Long 27 50 W

46. Saturday April 5th Commenced with fresh breezes
and cloudy heading to the N. E. by the W. nothing
in sight Noon 18 48 Long 29

47. Sunday April 6th Commenced with moderate
breezes and pleasant heading by the wind to N. W.
nothing in sight Noon Lat^o 20 20 N. Long 30 00

48. Monday April 7th Commenced with light breezes and
pleasant heading to the N. W. by the wind nothing in sight
Noon Lat^o 21 04 Long 30 04

49. Tuesday April 8th Commenced with light breezes
and pleasant weather steering N. W. nothing in sight
employed filling the Harbors Boats Noon 22 14 Long 31 07

50. Wednesday April 9th Commenced with light breezes
and pleasant heading to N. W. one sail in sight
Noon Lat^o 22 34 Long 32 32

51. Thursday April 10th All these 24 hours light
breezes and pleasant heading to N. W. the sail
in sight heading to S. W. Noon 23 27 Long 33 40

52. Friday April 11th all these 24 hours light airs and
calm lowered the Boats to exercise the crew
Noon 24 20 N. Long 34 30

53. Saturday April 12th All these 24 hours light airs
with calm. lowered the Boats to pull and row
Noon Lat^o 24 29 N. Long 34 40 W
