

Ship Pacific Outward Bound 1851

68. Sunday April 27th Commenced with light breezes and hazy heading N.E. saw the Island of Flores one of the Western Isles at 4 p.m. took to the sunset Flores bore N. 64 E. dist 17 miles at 2 p.m. took to daylight the land in sight heading to E.S.E.

Noon Lat. 38 46 Long 35 38

69. Monday April 28th Commenced with light breezes and hazy. the land in sight Middle part rainy. Later part light airs from N.W. with fog squalls kept off S.E.

Noon Lat 38 50 Long

70. Tuesday April 29th Commenced with light breezes and hazy. steering S.E. Middle part the land in sight the same the Islands of Laysan & Pico in sight to the S.E. saw finbacks Grampus porpoises and some sharks

Noon Lat 38 10 Long 29 52

71. Wednesday April 30th Commenced with light airs and calm. covered the 2 boats to lance some sharks the Islands in sight Middle part the same with fog. Squalls Later part fine weather steering E. for the land. nothing of any sporting fish in sight

Noon Lat 38 15 Long

72. Thursday April 30th May 1st Commenced with light breezes and pleasant heading in shore. picked up 3 land sails at 3 p.m. wore ship to the N.W. off shore sunset took in sail Middle part fog squalls wore ship to the S.E. daylight made sail. Laysan bearing E.S.E. dist 14 miles at 10 a.m. wore ship to the N.W. by the wind

Noon Lat 38 20 Long

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73. Friday May 2nd Commenced with light breezes and pleasant. Laysan in sight sunset took in sail Middle part the same steering N. daylight 2 sails in sight Later part fresh breezes S.E. steering N. finbacks in sight

Noon Lat 38 07 Long 30 49

74. Saturday May 3rd Commenced with fresh breezes and hazy. steering N. Middle part the same Later part fog. 11 sail of Whales spoke a French ship at 10 a.m. bound home full.

Noon Lat 37 30 Long 32 34

75. Sunday May 4th Commenced with fresh breezes & E. steering N. passed 12 sail of ship all steering to the E. sunset took in sail and wore too. Middle part the same daylight kept off N. with fresh breezes & E.

Noon Lat 37 08 Long 34 39 N.

76. Monday May 5th Commenced with fresh breeze from E.N.E. steering N. sunset took in sail wore too headed to the S.E. daylight made sail kept off N.W. strong breezes wore wore to under close reef maintop sail & stay sails

Noon Lat 36 38 Long 35 55 N.

77. Tuesday May 6th Commenced with fresh Gale from E.N.E. laying to Middle & Later part the same saw finbacks

Noon Lat 36 38 Long 36 15

78. Wednesday May 7th Commenced with fresh breezes and cloudy. Let the foretop sail close reef sunset wore to headed to the S. daylight Moderate made sail headed to the N.

Noon Lat 36 59 Long 36 27

79. Thursday May 8th All the 24 hours light breezes heading to the S.W. by the wind saw finbacks. Minding the maintop sail

Noon Lat 37 37 Long 37 46 N.
