

16 Ship Pacific off Western Islands 1854.

109. Saturday June 7th Commences with strong breeze
c. S.W. spoke the Brig Harbinger off Boston 2 Months
from Fayal. and boarded with her. So much laying off and on
on the Island of Terceira.

110 Sunday June 8th Commences with strong breeze
crossing of and on the Island Terceira sunset board
with the Harbinger. Latter part standing off shore
in company with Brig Harbinger.

111 Monday June 9th Commences with Moderate
breezes and pleasant standing in shore in company
with the Brig Harbinger pass a English Whaler Bark c.
sunset laying by with the Brig Harbinger & Bark President
c. 11 p.m. the Capt came on board. Middle part beating up
along shore at sunrise hove to off Port Praya. c. 7 a.m.
the Capt of the Harbinger came on board at 8 the Capt Silvia
& Capt Peas left for shore in company with the Capt of
the President. Latter part headed off shore.

112 Tuesday June 10th Commences with Moderate breeze
and pleasant heading in shore. Sunset wore ship
headed off shore with the Mountsail to the North
c. 9 a.m. the Capt on board. Bracia for wind off shore
Latter part strong breezes heading off and on 5 sails in
sight and a large Steam Ship so much.

113 Wednesday June 11th Commences with strong breeze
c. N.W. heading in shore sunset headed off Moderate
part heading in. Latter part headed off 5 sails in sight
with a heavy swell from N.W.

114 Thursday June 12th Commences with the breeze moderating
crossing of the Island of Terceira daylight headed off shore
7 sails in sight so much with jibbacks in sight.

115 Friday June 13th Commences with light airs
and Calm c. 5 p.m. boarded with the Brig
Harbinger Middle part Calm. Latter light airs
sent 2 Boats in shore to look for whales all the Boats
returned 4 sails in sight so much.

116 Saturday June 14th Commences with light airs
and Calm. heading off shore 4 sails in sight and
no whales Latter part running down along shore
c. 9 a.m. the Brig Harbinger's boat came alongside with
a fine Potatoes & Onions, nothing in sight but vessels
and the Land.

117 Sunday June 15th All these 24 hours light
breezes with frequent Calms boarded with the Brig
Harbinger daylight lowered the Boat's Boat and
pulled in shore after a fish Boat, bought 4 Large
fish and 2 Eels. 5 vessels in sight so much.

118 Monday June 16th First part of these 24 hours
light airs. with Calm nothing in sight vessels and
the Land. Middle & Latter part Moderate breezes
and fine weather 6 sails in sight also the Land
other

119 Tuesday June 17th All these 24 hours Moderate
breezes and Cloudy c. 10 a.m. St. George's Graciosa sailed
in sight also 6 sails of vessels Terceira about 6 miles
to the Westward

120 Wednesday June 18th First part of these 24 hours
Moderate breezes. boarded with the Brig Harbinger
Middle & Latter parts Calm with rain squalls
the Brig and Bark in sight also 3 Islands and
Terceira about 12 miles west to the West.
